
Warriors Assembly Evangelism Team








The Call To Service

There are many scriptures on the subject of faith in the bible. There are also many expressions of unequivocal faith as well as a total lack of faith. In our recent Faith Clinic, Bishop sought to help us as maturing believers to increase and deepen our faith so that we may not only be able to survive in this season but thrive.

Heb 11:1 defines faith as: "the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen." Faith is a spiritual transaction which is the reason that Paul said that it is the evidence of things not seen because for faith to work it must be demonstrated of things that can only be seen in the supernatural realm.

Bishop James said that "faith sees" because it sees that which is invisible to the natural eyes. Spiritual eyes are used to see that which faith does.

When I think about faith I often think on those biblical giants who possessed great faith and I also think of those who had very little faith. Jesus' biggest issue with his disciples was their lack of faith or unbelief and he commended those who stepped out in faith saying things to them like "your faith has made you whole."

Bishop James always tells us that "faith that is not tested cannot be trusted." This means that we must endure and pass the tests of our faith if we say that we are believers. I often find myself asking "where is your faith girl?" You see, I too sometimes doubt but we cannot live in doubt if we say that we are believers and that Christ lives in us. The two are contradictory.

I can say that my faith was not always where it is now and I am glad that it is not where it used to be. I had mustard seed faith (Matt 7:20) and even then I doubted my abilities and rightly so because we often trust our own abilities rather than God's ability.

God helped me to work through many personal insecurities and helped me to trust His ability to do things through me and for me. He helped me to see myself through His eyes. I am still not where I want to be in terms of my level of faith but I am here to encourage you in your faith that you will get there one day. It is a journey of love and trust.

My goal is to become like Paul who was fully persuaded of God's love for him. He had full faith in God's ability to do what He said He would do. (Rom 8:38-39, Rom 4:21). There are many avenues to victory but there is only one vehicle that will get you there and that is FAITH!

When and if you come to a place where you lack faith for a thing what should you do?

The first thing that you should do is get into the word because you need the word and a word to strengthen your faith and to have faith for the thing. Faith comes by hearing the WORD (Rom 10:17). Find scriptures on faith to build your faith.

Next, confess the word (Rom 10:9-10, Rom 4:17, Is 55:11, Num 23:9, Heb 10:23). Confessing the word is confessing God because He is His word!

Next, find like minded people to strengthen you. Ps 42:7, Prov27:17, Ps 1:1. People who have similar values, visions and goals are able to understand your struggles and will be able to give good counsel.

Lastly, be courageous. Whenever God spoke to someone he would tell them to "be of good courage" so that they would step out in faith and others could see God working in and through them. Be brave, be bold and stand in the truth and in the power of His might! If He be for you who can stand against you?

Dear brethren, I pray that your faith is strengthened and you will be encouraged. I pray that you will be able to move from the level of faith that you are on into a new and deeper dimension of faith. I pray that you will be able to strengthen others as your faith is renewed and deepened.


