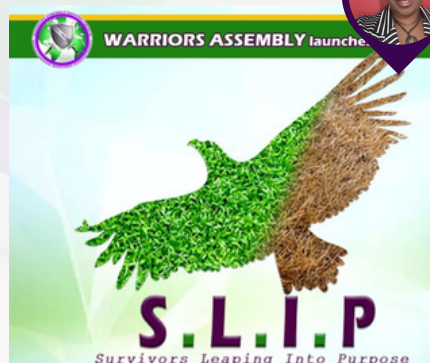
Warriors Assembly Evangelism Team

Prosperity - A matter of faith

Many times we think about prospering naturally but neglect to consider the prosperity of the spirit. The first thing that I want you to know is that the ENTIRE bible is a book about prosperity. It is laden with scriptures about prosperity.

When we think about prospering we think about money and whilst money and prosperity may be closely related physical money is only a manifestation of one's ability to work the scriptures and understand spiritual things (time, season, the move of God).

We do not become naturally rich by simply thinking about it nor do we become spiritually rich without displaying a level of faith. The bible declares that it is impossible to please God without faith.

The Christian journey is a FAITH walk and it is no cake walk! Jesus said in Matt 6:33 "Seek ye first the kingdom" of God and all other things will be added unto you. John reinforced spiritual prosperity in 3 Jn 1:2 saying "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth."

God is concerned about all things relating to you but our lack of faith in Him causes us to miss out on our blessings. How concerned are you about God's business? Jesus was most displeased not about the disciples' inability to cast out devils but their inability to trust and believe.

Faith is foundational to the successful navigation of the believer's walk with God. God desires your natural prosperity just as he desires your spiritual prosperity, after all, He said that HE will "add ALL other things" to us!

Why then, you may ask, are you not prospering naturally? The answer is simple, you are spiritually impoverished. It may be because you lack adequate teaching or it may be that your attitude to and perspective of spiritual

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There is no such thing as "The Prosperity Gospel", there is only the Gospel of Jesus Christ! The Gospel IS prosperity!

prosperity and the things of God is in need of an overhaul.

From the beginning with Adam, prosperity is written of in the bible. God placed Adam in the midst of prosperity. Gen 1:29, Gen 2:8-15 tell us that Adam was never hungry and that he was placed in the midst of prosperity with gold, onyx and four rivers surrounding him. He had all that he needed.

If this was how God created Him and he was placed in such grandeur, and God is does not change, why then would we believe that in our time He would not want the same for us?

There is no such thing as "The Prosperity Gospel", there is only the Gospel of Jesus Christ! The gospel IS prosperity! Biblical prosperity has very little to do with money but more to do with our relationship with Christ through which we gain the benefits of natural prosperity.

All those men and women of faith who prospered naturally in the bible were spiritually grounded and rooted in their relationship with God so my question to you today is this: What is your relationship with God like? What do you need to do to forge a deeper relationship with Him?

How are you going to put your faith into action to allow God to guide your footsteps into your wealthy place? David said in Ps 23:1 The Lord is my shepherd I SHALL NOT WANT; one translation says I LACK NOTHING so if you are lacking it is only because you are not trusting God to be your shepherd!

Begin to develop your faith by renewing your mind and delving into the scriptures. Ask God for insight, wisdom, knowledge and understanding because **IT IS YOUR TIME TO PROSPER!**
