

Health & Safety Policy

Part 1. Statement of intent

It is our health and safety policy to:

Seek to prevent accidents and ill health.

Regularly monitor and review our health and safety arrangements and make changes where necessary, informing staff appropriately.

Risk assessments

All risk assessments will be reviewed regularly and whenever business circumstances, hazards and/or risks alter

Training

All staff and contractors will be given appropriate training in health and safety matters so that they can carry out their work activities safely.

Staff will be trained in the appropriate use of any personal protective equipment provided.

Staff working remotely will be trained in additional arrangements to maintain their health and safety at work.

Staff will be consulted on health and safety matters when changes to health and safety arrangements are needed and as risk assessments are reviewed

Evacuation

Staff will be consulted about any evacuation plans or arrangements

Evacuation routes will be kept clear and will be well signposted

Evacuation routes will be kept clear and any evacuation plans will be tested regularly
