


2023 Health Stats-

This was among some of the highest in the state.













- Sumner County had a high rate of teen pregnancy








Sumner County Schools Vote Against Education
Freedom Scholarship Act-



- Host a Recycling Drive where members can bring their recyclables and volunteers take them to the local recycling center_____






Ways We Can Help Sumner County-

Tennessee Gov. Bill Lee (R) signed a bill that allows public offices to refuse to perform same-sex marriages.








Medicaid-

Property Owners from SquattersSquatters in the State of Tennessee have no rights, and in the case of squatters, property owners must take judicial evictions.







12,000 Tennessee 4th Graders are at Risk of Getting Held Back-







Congressional Republican Agenda Congressional Republicans want to slash the







Outbreak-

CDC has reported a spike in cases of the Measles in the U.S.








Abortion Navigators-

These services help cover costs and find places that perform abortions.






New Age Vape in Teens

higher number in states where THC and Cannabis are illegal.






Al in Healthcare

Al has advanced to the extreme within the last year. With this, Healthcare has seen some of the most advances.


Al called 'P-GAN' has been reported 100 times faster in producing retinal imaging.
