Company Description:

Brown's Dairy Dock is a family owned and operated seasonal ice cream and sandwich shop in Marblehead, Ohio. Brown's Dairy Dock has been in operation since 1992 by the Brown family. It was purchased in 2020 by the Foye family. An ice cream shop has been on this corner since the 1950s. Brown's Dairy Dock is in a key location called "Vacationland" and is enjoyed by residents, tourists, and employees of area businesses. Brown's Dairy Dock is a member of The Marblehead Peninsula Chamber of Commerce and Marblehead Merchants Group.

Attractions near Brown's Dairy Dock include Lakeside Chatauqua (a cultural arts, educational and family community), Kelleys Island Ferry, Marblehead Lighthouse and East Harbor State Park. Area workers are employed by the Coast Guard station, quarry, essential businesses such as the bank, Biro manufacturing, Danbury school, Marblehead Police and Fire Departments and seasonal workers from local shops and attractions. The U.S. Coast Guard station has been noted to be the busiest station on the Great Lakes.

Marblehead, located on the shores of fresh water Lake Erie, is across the Sandusky Bay from one of the most popular theme parks - Cedar Point Amusement Park. Dairy Dock is on a main road and attracts first time visitors going to the islands and families that have been staying at nearby resorts and campgrounds for decades. One notable resort is Baypoint Marina and beach. A family's visit to the area is not complete without visiting Brown's Dairy Dock.

Grooming requirements are consistent with local and state health department. Hair must be pulled up or under a hat. Employees must remain clean as required by health department. Two uniform shirts are issued as is a hat. More shirts can be purchased at cost.

The business does not allow smoking. The apartment where the employees will be staying is a non-smoking residence.

The work schedule is posted one week prior. The schedule is done one week at a time. Workers traveling to work from overseas will receive a minimum of 32 hours of work per week. More work is likely to be available, up to 40 hours. Other businesses in the area will need workers too and if this does not interfere with employment at Brown's Dairy Dock. As your sponsor, we would require priority scheduling prior to additional outside employment.

Cell phones are not permitted while working. Cell phones are kept in the break room and employees are provided with sufficient break time.
