The housing might not have a lot of amenities. Many accommodations do not come with a washer or dryer so students go to laundromats. There might not be access to a full kitchen. Many students find accommodations in homestays or extended stay motels. You should be prepared that housing could be small, shared and anywhere from 1-5 miles from employer. Students must research housing options online and secure housing prior to arrival. CIEE will ask you to provide your housing information at least two weeks before your departure to the US. Flying into Boston Logan Airport is the easiest location as bus transportation is available from the airport to Hyannis Transportation Center (HTC). The bus ride is approximately two hours and Hyannis is 17 miles from the restaurant. Plymouth & Brockton Bus (<https://www.p-b.com/full-schedule>) and Peter Pan Bus (<https://peterpanbus.com>) both provide service from Boston to Hyannis. Purchasing your ticket in advance is required. Cape Cod is a rural vacation destination with limited transportation. Bus transportation is provided through Cape Cod Regional Transit (<http://www.capecodtransit.org/>). Please be sure to check the website before you make flight arrangements. Keep in mind, if you arrive to Cape Cod at night and/or weekends you limit your ability to take CCRTA transportation and may need to rely upon a taxicab (Town Taxi, Cape Cab or UBER, both expensive). We don't provide transportation from Hyannis to the restaurant.
