# Our story

Years Ago... The Ritchie family first arrived at the Perth Military Settlement on March 28th, 1816. They were one of the original group of ten families that emigrated from Scotland and established the Scotch Line settlement. They were fortunate to receive this land grant of over 100 acres with 1,200 ft. frontage on the Tay River. Although the land here was marginal for agricultural production, the Ritchie family prospered by obtaining timber rights to large tracts of forested land setting up sawmills on the Tay River and Grant's Creek. As the family fortunes grew, the modest settler's stone cottage built in 1820's had two more levels added with a wraparound 2nd storey veranda - all inspired by the architectural vision of creating a Palladian villa in the Canadian wilderness.

In the late 1800s the Ritchie family sold the farm which continued for the next hundred years to operate as a dairy farm with small-scale pork and poultry production - first owned by the Munroe's who later sold it to the Menzie's. By the late 1900s the farm passed to new owners - the Moxon family who came for weekend retreats and eventually retired here.

In 2005, Michael Glover purchased the farm and brought with him a dream to save the built and cultural heritage of this place by breathing new life into the homestead. After foundations were fixed, roofs replaced, barns power-washed and re-wired - it was too beautiful not to share with others! So, onto the next step - washrooms were built, stages and terraced landscapes were erected, kitchen space was created and signs were installed. Out of this labour of love Ecotay Education Centre was born... a place where the neighbours, friends and family could once again experience the rich heritage and magical sharing of a good old-fashioned country gathering.

Fast forward to June 2021 when Natasha Lackey, Justin Lackey, and Sarah Noonan became the sixth family to call Ecotay home and continue the vision of Ecotay !

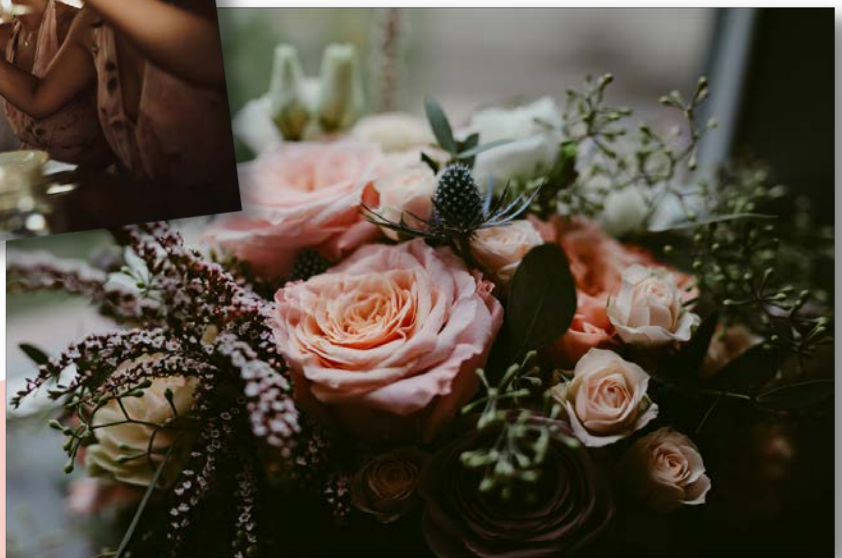


# Weddings

The idea of hosting weddings at Ecotay had a very innocent beginning... In 2007, Michael's daughter Alex, and her partner Ryan, had the idea that if the Horse Shed was just cleaned up, it would be a perfect setting to celebrate their marriage vows. Friends and family swooped in from all around to join in the task, paintbrushes and scrub cloths in-hand, to turn their concept into a reality. One might think that this would be a one-time event here at the farm but it lead to several years of restoration frenzy!

The barns were attracting so much attention that in 2011 Dennis Noonan, a neighbour of Michael's, asked about having his own daughter Natasha's wedding at Ecotay. That was the beginning of full-blown demand for couples dreaming of tying the knot in a rustic, chic farm setting! But the story gets better! That couple from down the road was able to buy Ecotay when the time came in 2021 for the property to be sold. Natasha Noonan, along with her husband Justin Lackey, partnered with her cousin, Sarah Noonan who also grew up around the corner on Noonan Side Road.

# Barn again!

The two century-old Ecotay site is a magical space for both large and small groups to gather. When renting this space, the site is clean, fresh and well-groomed... setting the stage for an unlimited scope of creativity in adding your personalized touch.

## **Cow Barn**

The largest of all the barns, the cow barn once housed a 40-head dairy operation. In fact, the Ecotay logo is based on the cow stanchions that held the cattle in place while being milked. This multi-use barn is perfect for everything from exhibits, trade shows and book fairs to charmingly elegant sit-down wedding feasts. The hayloft offers a quieter space with an amazing view to below and boasts a very unique acoustic quality.

## **Pig Barn Café**

The feeding trough and “pig entrance” doors are all that is left from the pig operation days. It has been turned into a kitchen and dining area complete with all modern utilities. The butcher block counter tops and refinished wooden walls and small woodstove make this a warm and cozy gathering space. For large events, such as weddings and fundraisers, caterers love this space as it functions very well as a food prep and plating kitchen.

## **Horse Shed**

Once home to a team of horses and a buggy, this barn has been transformed into a dance and music hall. With a fully accessible stage, it is excellent for any kind of performance – from choirs and orchestras and full-size bands to soloists, speakers, dancers and actors. The ambiance and acoustics in the Horse Shed are praised and applauded by both performers and audience alike.

## **Chicken Coop**

The Chicken Coop, complete with original brood boxes, is located behind the stage area in the Horse Shed. It can be used as a small seminar space, a “green room” for performance events or is sometimes called The Hen House when bridal parties convene here for the pre-ceremony makeup, hair-styling and dressing session.



# Details

## **Barnyards**

The terraced pathways throughout the site are defined by 90 tons of spectacular fieldstone – giving a nod to the hard work and pioneer spirit of Lanark County. The split rail cedar fences enclose many different outdoor programming spaces such as different sized patios and lush green pastures. Bar Shed Situated near the washrooms and across from the Horse Shed, this rustic bar features an antique workbench used as the refreshments serving counter along with a large shelf for display and storage. A fridge and freezer are located behind the bar area.

## **Outhouses**

There are definitely no shortage of washrooms at Ecotay! Twelve washrooms, complete with modern amenities and plumbing, are cleverly disguised in several different wooden outhouses that appear like they have been here for centuries. Parking A field at the entrance to Ecotay has been dedicated to parking for visitors. Prior to events, however, vehicles can access the site via a roadway that winds through central site making it easier for deliveries of equipment, food and other supplies.

## **Accessibility**

Ecotay has a wheelchair/walker friendly washroom, a ramp to the stage area and walkways that have a hard and smooth compacted fine gravel finish. Please note that, upon request, a vehicle will be given access to the road leading to the main areas.

## **WiFi**

The site has WiFi available for guests. Please ask about how to gain access.

## **Safe Water**

The Ecotay water is beautiful, fresh, clean-tasting from the well. It safe to drink, as it is governed by filter system that constantly guarantees its purity.

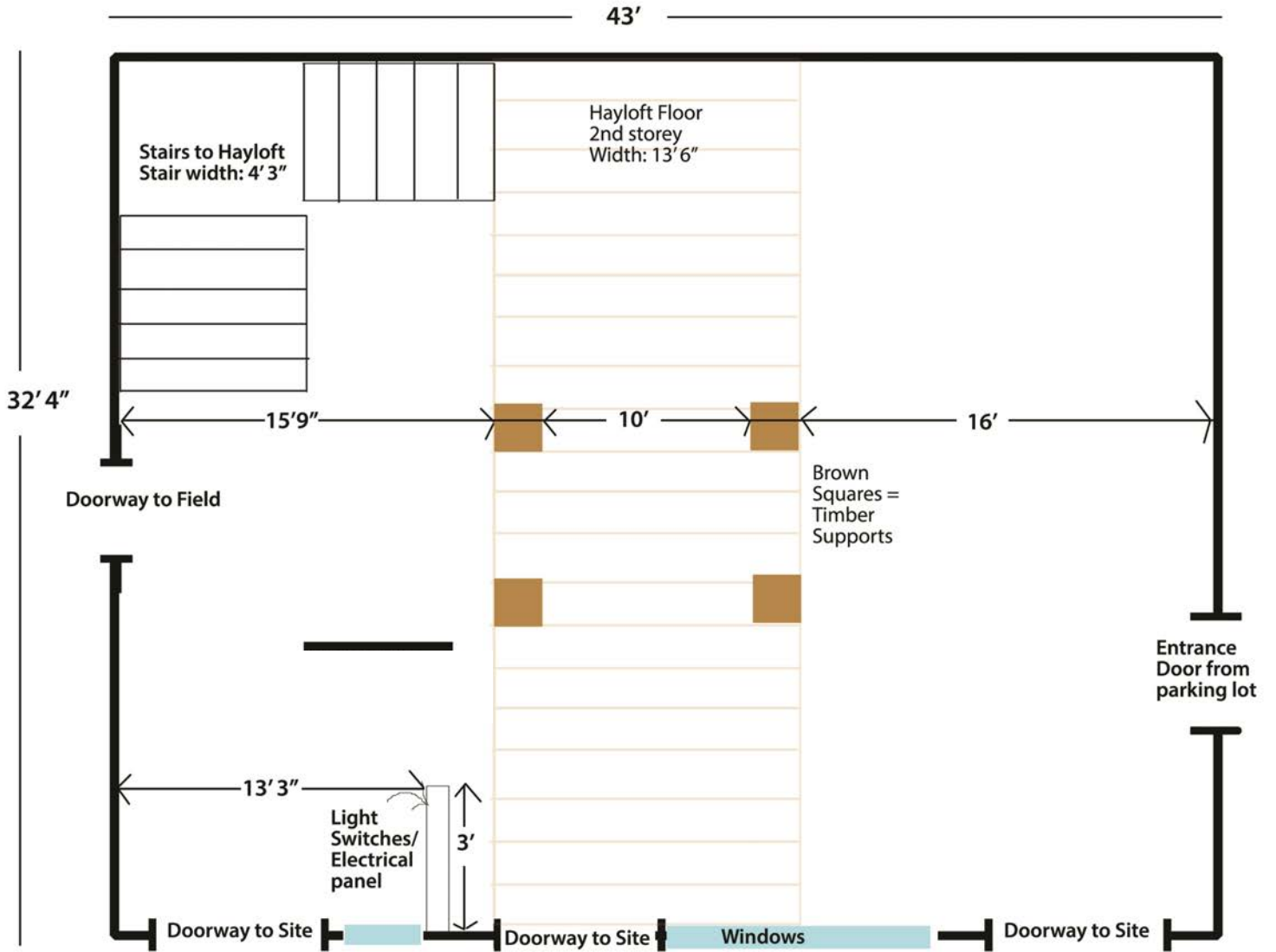
## **Septic System**

The Ecotay septic system is an Eco- Flow, high-capacity unit. Please do not flush any feminine hygiene products or diapers down the toilets!

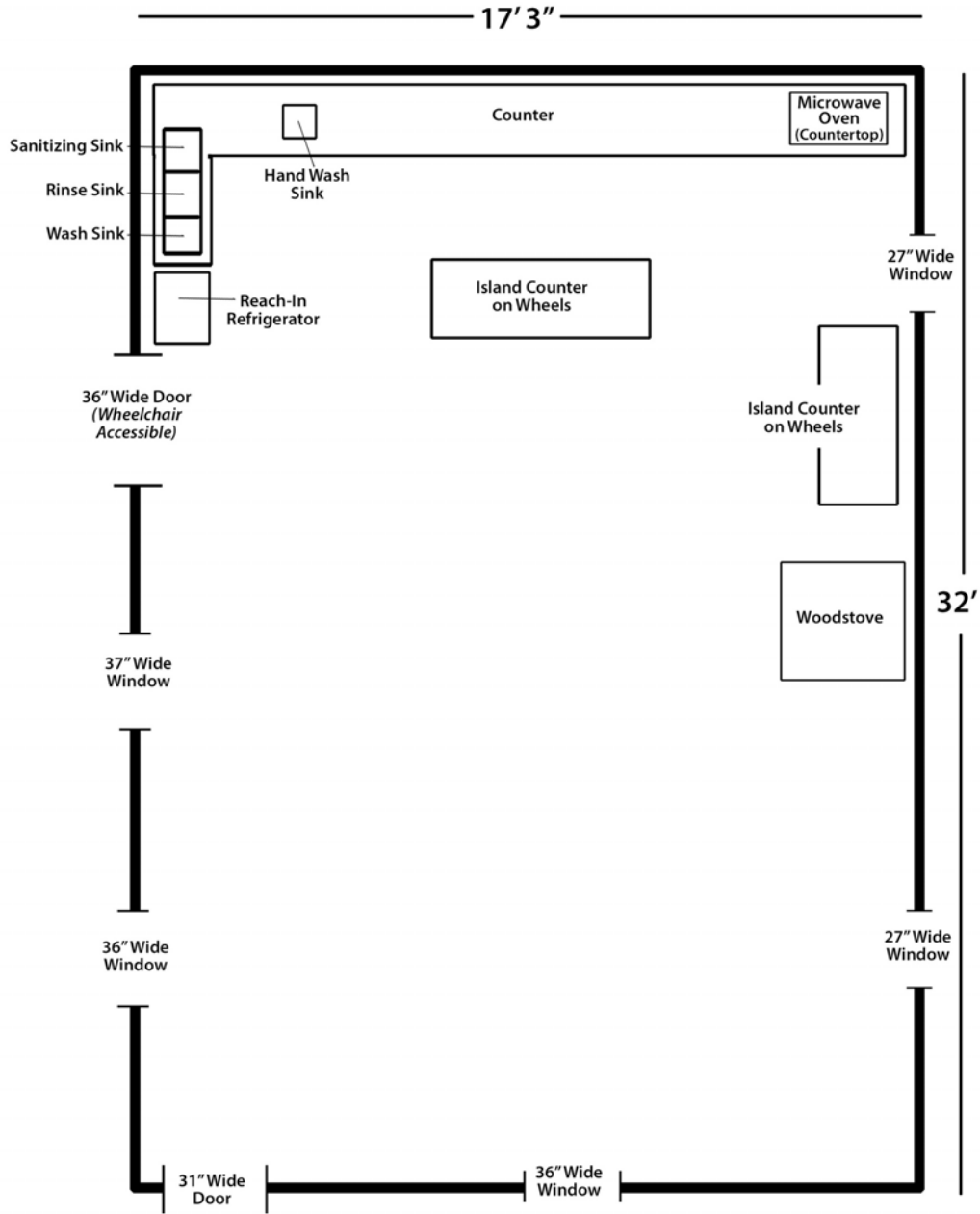




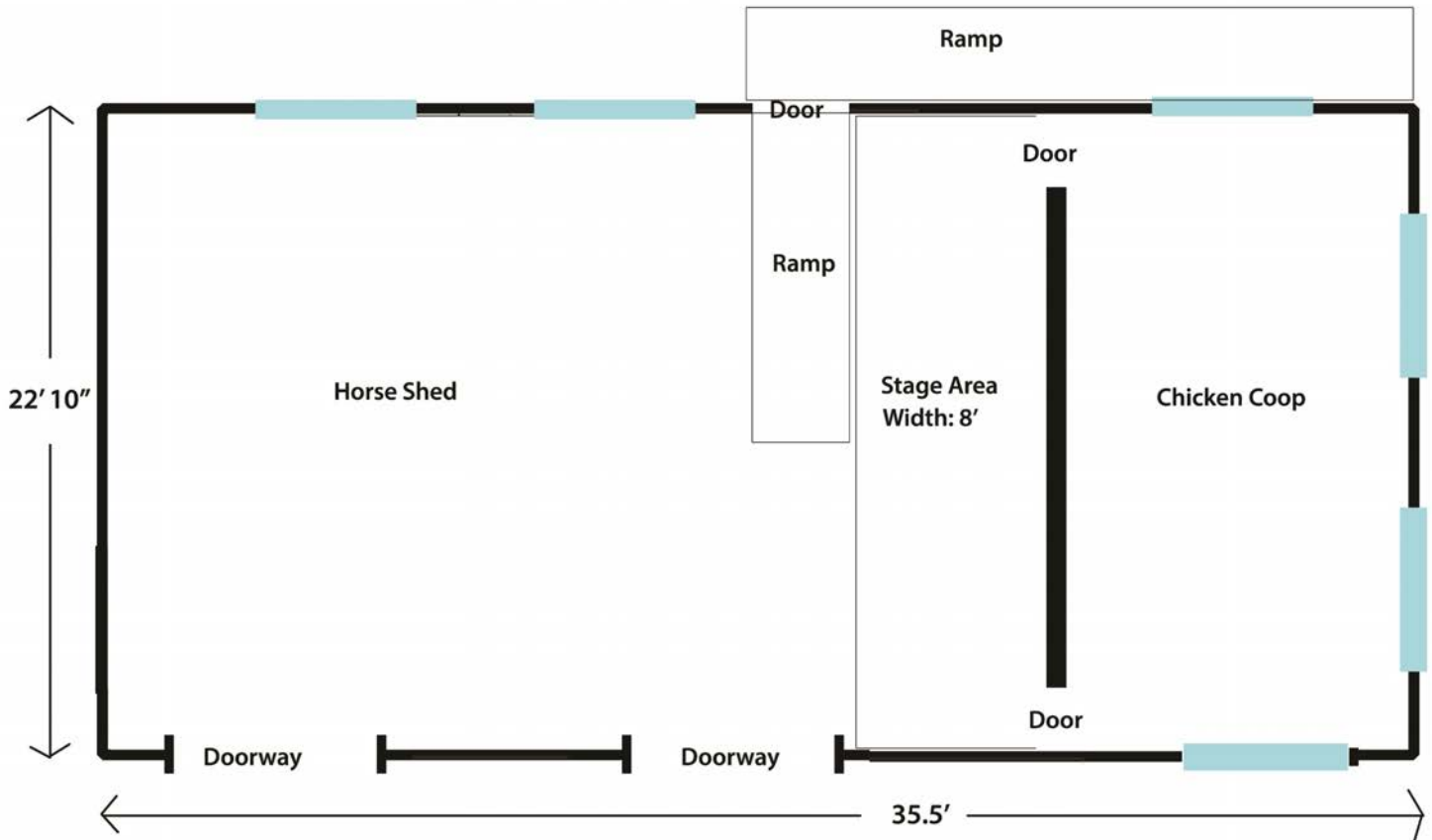
# Cow Barn



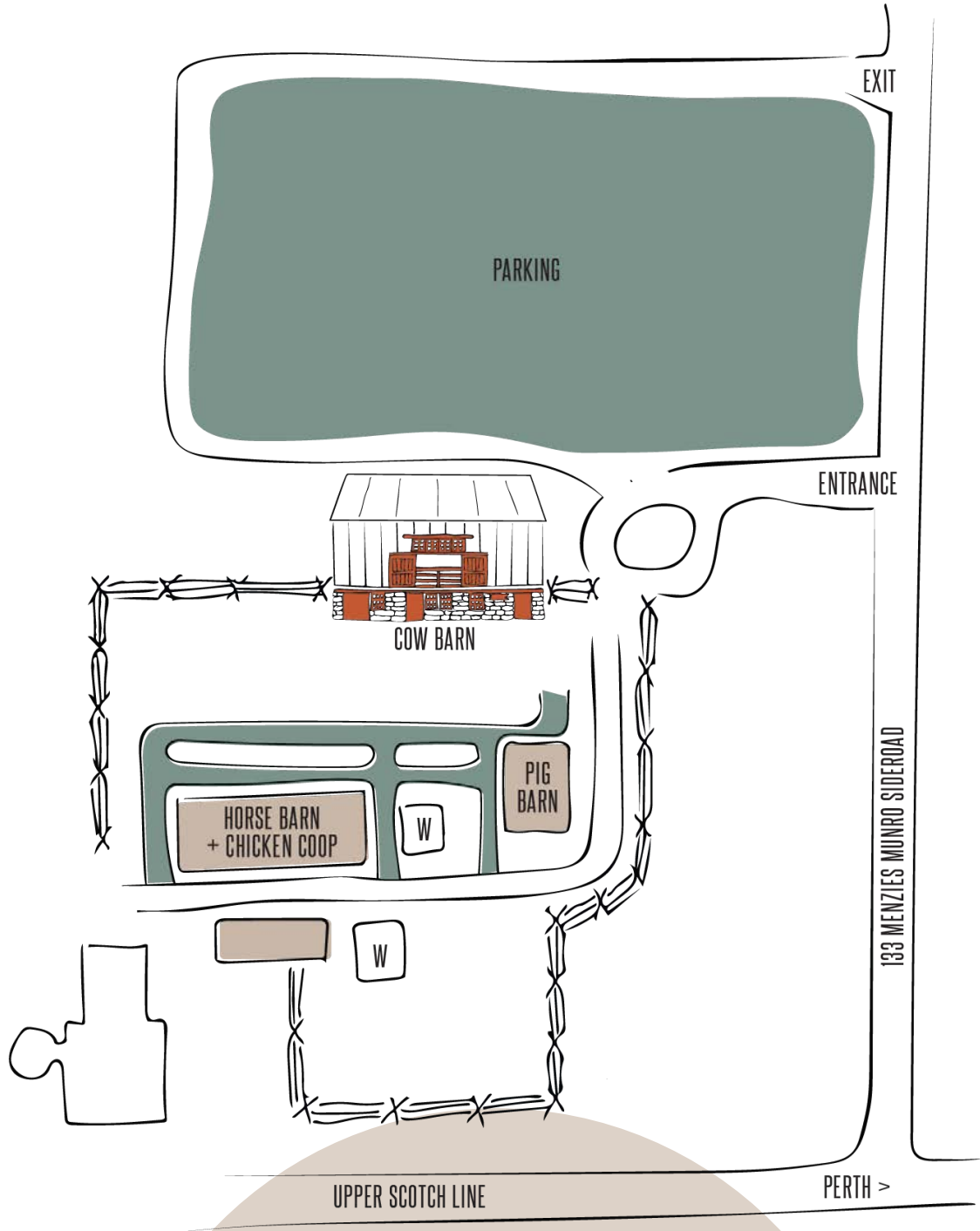
# Pigg Barn

Our 111 acre farm, actually located on an island, is bordered on the north with 1,200 ft. frontage on the Tay River. The farmland consists of 30 acres pasture land, 30 acres tree plantation, 30 acres mixed forest land, 10 acres wetlands and 5 acres gardens, buildings and recreational land.
