

CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this organization shall be Upper Milford Field and Stream Association.

ARTICLE II

OBJECT

The object of the Association shall be to promote the practice of field sports among its members, to protect the game and fish of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and to abide by all laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

To encourage the preservation and propagation of game and fish, and to do all things incidental thereto, or connected therewith, including the stocking and restocking of fields, woods, and streams with game and fish, the replanting of forests and the ownership and maintenance of property and streams suitable for the preservation and propagation of same.

ARTICLE III

OFFICERS

The officers of the Association shall consist of President, Vice-President, Recording Secretary, Financial Secretary, Treasurer, Head Trustee and trustees. The number of Trustees shall be determined by the Executive Board each year.

ARTICLE IV

NOMINATIONS AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS

SECTION 1. All officers shall constitute the Executive Board

SECTION 2. All officers referred to in Article III shall be nominated at the regular stated meetings in October, November or December of each year and elected at the regular meeting in December of that same year and assume their duties in January of the upcoming year. All officers shall serve for a period of one year (12 months).

SECTION 3. Eligibility for office shall be limited to active members of the Association who are in good standing for a period of 3 years on the night of the elections.

- 3A. A member in good standing is any member attending a meeting or club activity is an active member. Any active member who is current on his/her dues & has not violated any club rules is considered in 'good standing'.
- 3B. A violation of club rules must be reviewed by the executive board. A member must be notified by certified mail that a violation has occurred and what appropriate action has been taken.

SECTION 4. Members must be an active member in good standing for one year in order to vote in the election of officers.

SECTION 5. Any officer of this Association who is absent for more than three consecutive meetings shall be required to justify his/her absence or submit his/her resignation.

SECTION 6. Resignation of any office shall be submitted in writing to the Executive Board.

SECTION 7. In any case that an officer's position becomes vacant, the following goes into effect. If the officer's position is vacant for less than three months, the executive board shall appoint a member in good standing to fill the vacant office. If the office is vacant for more than three months, a member in good standing shall be nominated at the next regular meeting, then voted on by the members in good standing who are at that meeting. If elected, the member shall assume the duties of the office immediately. If the member nominated does not meet "Section 3. Eligibility for office", the board of officers may override the requirement for eligibility for office, only with a unanimous vote of officers present, for the nominated member.

ARTICLE V

AMENDMENTS

Amendments to the Constitution must be presented in writing at a regular stated meeting of the members of the Association. They shall be signed by at least three members in good standing. They shall be discussed at this first meeting and they shall be presented in their altered form (if any) for discussion at a second meeting. At the third meeting they shall be presented in their final form, at which time they shall be accepted or rejected by two-thirds (2/3) majority vote.
