Hi Thomas,

Appreciate the response but unfortunately you are rightly unable to send anyone out on a regular basis as no sooner has a road sweeper been , the next lorry entering and leaving creates the mess again. I have seen lorries approaching which were leaving mud on the roads and as there is no wheel wash facility at the entry / exit point vehicle leave in a real mess as the coup road is a sea of mud. Until they fix the road and install a wheel wash the problem and complaints will continue to be sent to us on a regular basis.

Someone on site has told the community police officer that the have a road sweeper operating four times a week, I heard one this morning at around 10am, if that's the daily visit used then what happens for the rest of the day? As I write this I hear another road sweeper but cannot guarantee it's at the coup, lasted about 1 minute, these sweepers are normally hired by the hour.

The entrance is an absolute mess with very large potholes and the roads leading away from it are starting to break up badly, potholes appearing everywhere. Unfortunately until the coup is closed for good the mess will continue and the roads will keep breaking up.
