Thanks for the update.

Do they show you their construction plan which details exactly what they should be doing. They should have a wheel washer at the exit of the site which cleans the exiting vehicles before entering the road, they do not have one.

One sweep of the road on four different days does not cut it, the number of lorries entering and leaving the site varies and it only takes one tipper to leave the site after the road has been swept for the road to be back to having mud and stones on it again. The sweeper really needs to clean the road at least three times a day for it to remain safe, it is a well-used road and too many vehicles speed along it, who is at fault if there is an accident.

Can you advise us on the name of the company who are running the site?

Good morning,

I have been up to the site and spoke with the site manager. The team were extremely helpful and told me they have been visited by the council and SEPA separately. They are using road sweepers 4 times a week to maintain the road and are using 2 separate companies to ensure they get this many.

I can confirm myself that there are road sweepers in attendance as I was behind one yesterday around 12pm on Birdston Road.

I have seen this morning there is dirt on the road and the weather conditions appear to be making this worse but the workers were out themselves sweeping what they could off of the road. The site manager appears to be strict on his workers in terms of keeping the road clear and as the site is being ran by an environmental company they do understand the dangers associate with the mud and are keeping on top of it.

Hopefully this puts residents at ease.

We are receiving complaints about the condition of the road at the entrance to Birdston Coup and the roads leading away towards Kirkintilloch and Milton of Campsie.

There are 20 ton tipper trucks regularly running into the coup and the roads are covered in mud and stones, eventually someone is going to have an accident. I have contacted EDC and SEPA and as this is a road safety issue we reckoned the police should have their say.

This has been going on for months now, in the dry weather it was only dust, now its constant mud and stones being left behind, there are no wheel washers or sweepers ever in attendance as there should be, surely it is in the police remit to look into dangerous situations like this.
