You may be unaware of a situation arising in Milton of Campsie at present in relation to core path access. The path to the south side of Birdston Coup has been closed off at both ends by the installation of Heras fencing. We have been receiving many complaints about the condition of the roads and paths around the current works at Birdston coup and feel that closing the well-used path off is totally unacceptable as is the closure of the access to the paths through the woods at Birdston Road just north of the old railway path.

As EDC Access Officer we would like to know what actions you will be taking to have these well used routes reopened as soon as possible.
