




CBCD Guest Requirements

This is an official event hosted by The Crewe of Bobbie C Davis. The float will provide an open bar (with moderation) and both sex bathrooms. As such there are certain requirements for you to complete in order to enter the float area – including riding on the float during the parade.

- 1.) This event will require a \$25 donation to the crewe for each participating person. There is a payment portal located at the bottom of our website – <u>www.CBCD.org.</u> When remitting payment, add the full names of all participants you are paying for.
- 2.) The <u>2018 CBCD Adult Guest Release Form</u> must be printed, filled out and emailed to the crewe, prior to the day of the event, for each guest participating in the event. Remit these documents to <u>CBCDPayments@Gmail.com</u>. Both documents and portal can be found at CBCD.org
- **3.)** Forms and payment must be submitted prior to 6pm the day before the event.
- **4.)** Dress code has been relaxed to include anything comfortable and appropriate.

Parade

- Participants may arrive as early as 4 pm to set up unless otherwise designated.
 - Build float
 - Touch up existing float
 - Practice any routines
- All entries must be in place by 6:00 pm.
- All vehicles must in place by 5:30 pm.
- Vehicles must have keys available at all times.
- No loud music until you get to Bayshore.
 - Do sound check prior to arrival
 - All equipment must be wrapped and weather proofed
 - Turn on amplified music when you turn onto Bayshore Dr.
- Vehicles must have wheel monitors.
 - Two <u>per</u> vehicle

General Information - Parade

- There is a "no alcohol" policy in the parade staging area
 - Recommended to only bring and use pre-labeled bottled containers
- No reserved parking
 - Obey all "resident only" parking areas
 - Avoid parking in the Old Northeast Neighborhood (as noted above)
 - Get there early! Remember, the Celebration Zone opens at 2pm and is within walking distance of the Parade staging area at Vinoy Park.
- Items to remember
 - Ponchos
 - Plastic covers for electronics
 - Zip ties
 - Water



- Consider parking towards the end of the route and take the Looper back north
- The St Pete High Park & Ride is free and will run until mid-night
- The Central Ave Trolley will run until 2:00am
- City owned parking garages max their parking rates at \$10 per night

Parade Distributing Items

- Avoid throwing items from moving vehicles
- Use parade walkers to distribute and toss items
- Only toss items that have intrinsic value
 - Beads
 - Koozies
 - Bracelets
- Avoid distributing leaflets, brochures, or flyers.
