



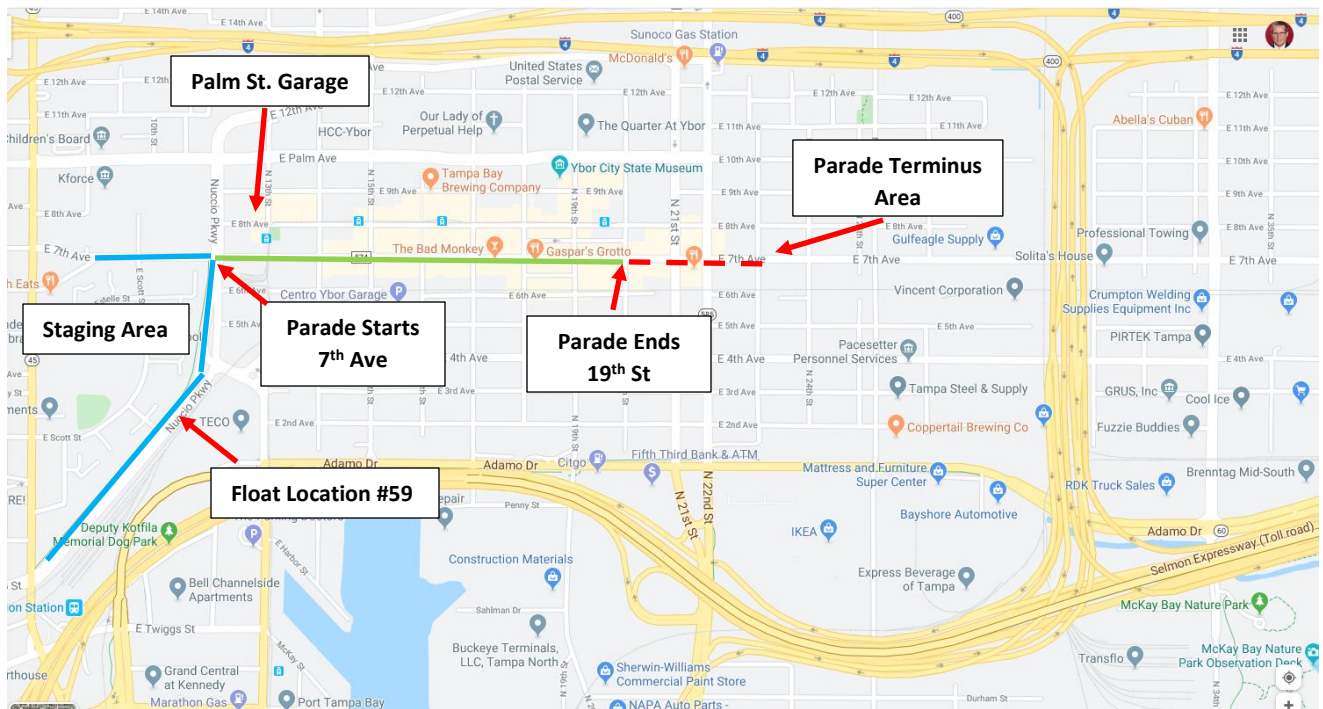
2020 Krewe of Sant Yago Knight Parade February 8th, 2020

This year's Krewe of Sant' Yago Knight Parade will be held on **Saturday, February 8th January 25, 2020**, starting at 7:00 p.m. You must be at the float for a safety meeting by 6:00 pm.

The Crewe of Bobbie C Davis is FLOAT #59

STAGING

All participants need to be at the float at **6pm** for safety instruction. Parking for this parade is usually in the City of Tampa Palm St Garage.



GENERAL RULES OF PARTICIPATION:

1. You are required to sign for, and wear, a numbered **PARADE WRISTBAND**. If you do not wear a numbered wrist band you may be asked to leave the parade route. You must have a **PARADE wristband** prior to the parade or they may deny you access to the parade route.
2. You must have a **FLOAT WRISTBAND** which provides you access to the float and allows you to be vended alcohol. Make sure that you bring your **DRIVER'S LICENSE to the parade!** The **FLOAT WRISTBAND** is evidence that we have checked your ID and that you are of legal age to drink.



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3. **No PARADE WRISTBANDS will be issued at the parade.** They must be obtained prior to the Friday BEFORE the event. All wristbands can be obtained by visiting the office of:

4. Throwing beads **PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF THE PARADE** is not permitted. Also, stay out of the street to allow parade and emergency vehicles through. No loud music in staging area.
5. All participants must wear a costume similar in style to the organization theme. Sailors (NOT PIRATES) wearing a mix of khaki, red, white and/or blue.
6. Throwing any beads, plastic or bead rings into any body of water is **ILLEGAL!** Please use the trash receptacles for any additional plastic bags, bead rings and empty drink containers, etc.
7. Tow unit driver's, marshals and the safety officer are not permitted to toss out throws. The driver and the safety officer need to stay with the tow vehicle, at all times, in the staging area.
8. Once the Parade is rolling, the float will not stop for any reason other than emergency or an official Parade stop. The float should not accelerate during the parade, but all participants will need to stay behind the front of the tow vehicle and no more than 20 feet behind the float.
9. Beverages will not be vended to any containers outside the standard ones supplied by the crewe. Please REUSE and RECYCLE where possible.
10. The Safety Office will wear a green safety vest. All marshals will wear an orange safety vests. These volunteers are SOBER and are there to look after YOUR SAFETY and that of other participants. Failure to FOLLOW THEIR INSTRUCTIONS or any abusive and/or belligerent behavior will be grounds for removal from the parade route by law enforcement.

DISEMBARKING

The end of the parade is located at **7th Ave and 19th St.** All participants need to either be off of the float by the end of the parade, or they will need to remain on the float until arriving at the parade terminus area located at **7th Ave and 24th St.** The stairs will be folded up at the end of the parade until arriving at the parade terminus area which will be identified by TPD at the end of the parade. A noticeable song (**BABY SHARK**) will be played approximately two blocks prior to the end of the parade in order to alert participants of their location.
