Handled Group 1 both davs. And. to top it all off. passed both legs to earn his Farm Dog title. Freddie is co-owned and loved by





**Report of the Secretary** -- Submitted club news for next issue of the Bulldogger; submitted annual report to the TN Sec of State. Received a letter from Music City requesting donations for the Nationals. (See attached letter).

**Report of the Treasurer**. Transition to Y-12 completed on May 12, 2022. Insurance—Suzan has contacted both the Insurance Group and carriage hill for quotes IF we do not get insurance by June 1 does that mean that we should stop any intake of new rescues? Joleen's groups insure under "umbrella" policies of the national organizations. Why doesn't BCA have such a policy. Something to be discussed with National officers. If we do not have insurance in place by June 1 we will have to suspend intake of rescues and in person events. Denise volunteered to follow up with other Rescue groups about their insurance policies. Mari will send Denise the link to BCARN rescue members.

#### Report of Committees

<u>Show</u> Received a letter from Music City BC requesting donations for a raffle they are putting together for the Nationals. Letter is attached. Should we make a contribution of goods or money? Nikki volunteered to see about soliciting donations for the raffle. If she is not successful by our next board meeting in July, we will consider making a monetary donation. Mari will get the information on the November nationals to Nikki along with the 2022 logo and our 501c3 form. <u>Rescue (see Excel file). In April we placed Daisy and Poe. Unfortunately, Poe was diagnosed with a brain tumor and he crossed over on April 30. Currently we have four dogs receiving medical treatment. Eddie is with Nikki and had surgery for</u> ACL on May 12. BCARN is covering the cost through a grant. GinGin, Cosmo and Beans are at Central. Cosmo and GinGin have been placed as of May 13. Hemi will come into rescue next week and I may have a home for her.

<u>Programs</u> Sent another reminder email to Ashley Richardson about a performance Bulldog event. Any other thoughts for programs? We discussed getting a speaker on CPR and first aid for dogs as a program.


