









From the East

Brethren,

I never know what to write when I sit down to do this. This time is different. With the onset of the Covid 19 virus everything has suddenly changed. There is a panic response and the grocery store shelves are empty for the most part. Bread, meat, dairy products and canned goods are, or seem to be gone. In preparation for the 3rd Saturday breakfast in March I found myself getting up at 4 am to stand in line at Walmart to get what we needed for that occasion. Still, even after going to 3 stores at opening time there was no bread or potatoes. I haven't been back to the stores yet, so I don't know if the panic buying is still ongoing.

My point in bringing this up is that I know we all need to be safe and feel prepared. That, apparently, means a lot of different things to a lot of different people. Taking common sense measures while erring on the safe side is my personal approach. I do not hoard at the grocery store. I buy as I would normally. As of Wednesday, March 18th I received the following from M.W. Louis J. Castle, Grand Master of Masons in Nevada:

"I hereby order all Masonic Meetings in the State of Nevada closed between now and April 17 in compliance with Governor Sisolak's order to close all nonessential businesses for thirty days which specified meeting halls as nonessential."

Please keep in mind that as this situation remains fluid things are subject to change. I will do my best to keep all brothers of Pahrump Lodge 54 informed.
