DETAILS

Phonics literacy curriculum, materials & teachers provided to struggling Lakota readers.

Annual collaborative food drive for local community & church pantries.

Partnered with Lakota Nutrition to provide food, mentorship & activities in 3 low income communities.

Back-to-school supply drive for Lakota students in need served by Reach Out Lakota.

Annual tennis shoe & boot drive for area clothing pantries & children in need.

Christmas gift drive for local children in need served by Reach Out Lakota.

Year round partnership with West Chester Presbyterian Church & Stepping Forward supporting their weekly community supper programs.

OUTCOME

60 Lakota students participated in our 16week after school tutoring program at three Lakota school locations.

17 church & community partners collected 14,776 lbs. of food & \$900 for 11 area pantries.

Staff, church partner volunteers & community partners provided 41 enrichment activities to 199 children for 10 weeks.

16 church partners collected \$21,705 in school supplies helping 329 Lakota students start school. A 125% donation increase from 2024!

Donor match secured for first 500 pairs of new & gently shoes collected by church partners.

11 church partners helped provide gifts for 1100 area children in need at Christmas.

Programs collectively now serving ~500 meals each week to those in need in our community.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

2025 has been a year of "marching on" as a Faith Alliance church and community partner collaborative. As Jesus taught, we continue to "feed, give, invite and visit" the children and families who cannot afford basic needs or access to educational supplies and tutoring opportunities leading to future economic success. We anticipate increasing need for food, clothing and school supplies in 2026 as the economic climate fluctuates. We will exercise stewardship of our financial resources to provide basics as well as afterschool and summer tutoring. We invite our students to be curious, to read, and explore new areas of interest through visits to our summer lunch sites from groups such as the Cincinnati Museum Center, Metroparks, Book Bums, and LEHS football team volunteers in 2026. We help people today so they may sustain themselves for a lifetime.
