DUES & FEES FOR 2024

As of 10/2/2023

Annual Dues:

- Membership is for one calendar/fiscal year, January 1st through December 31st.
- First (Adult) Membership
 - \$25.00
- Second Membership (within a Family; Adult or Junior)
 - +10.00
- Family (3 or more adults and children)
 - \$40.00 total
- Junior Membership
 - A Junior member is one who is under 18 years of age.
 - Parent or guardian must always also join and accompany the junior member at all activities.
 - Junior membership is non-voting.

Fees:

- Only club members may use the workshop or participate in classes.
- Workshop Fee: See Workshop & Class Fees Policy
- Class Fee: See Workshop & Class Fees Policy
- Fees are payable at the end of each workshop or class session in cash, check payable to WG&MS, or credit/debit card.
- One free class for each new (non-renewal) member.

Workshop & Class Fees Policy

Approved 11/6/2023; Updated 3/11/2024

Foundational Principles of this Policy:

- The instructors are WGMS members who are volunteering their time as part of the educational purposes of WGMS.
- Since shop owners/instructors are volunteering their personal workshops/equipment for use by WGMS, any fee charged is determined by the shop owner/instructor.
- An essential part of instruction on using equipment and the actual use of equipment is learning to and maintaining that equipment. Proper cleaning of equipment and workspace will be a regular ending to every class and/or workshop session. However, clean-up/maintenance time is not included in, nor payable as workshop/class time.
- Students may supply their own materials for use in class or purchase them from the instructor.

Lapidary and Metal Smithing Workshop Fees:

- The hours of workshop availability are at the discretion of the shop owner.
- \$5.00 per hour, payable to WG&MS.
- The instructor determines the materials and class fees, payable to the instructor. Be sure you know what the fee is before the class starts.

Class Fees:

- Most class sessions will be 3-4 hours. Be sure you know what the fee is before the class starts.
- Payment is due to the instructor at the end of the session; cash, check payable to WG&MS, or credit/debit cards are accepted.
