13	II. PROPOSED CLAIMS PROCEDURES	
14	Pursuant to this Court's November 8, 2023, order, and Nevada Revised Statutes 32.335,	
15		
16	the Receiver Geoff Winkler, hereby moves this Court for an order in aid of receivership	
17	providing the following relief: (1) setting a claims filing deadline, (2) approving proposed claim	
18	submission process, and (3) approving summary claims procedures.	
19	A. Claims Filing Deadline	
20	Pursuant to NRS 32.335(2), the Receiver requests the Court set a claims filing deadline	
21	ninety (90) days following the entry of the Order in Aid of Receivership (the "Claims Filing	
22		
23	Deadline"). All claims must be received by the Receiver not later than the Claims Filing	
24	Deadline. Any investor or creditor who fails to submit a claim form by mail to American	
25	Fiduciary Services by the Claims Filing Deadline shall be forever barred and enjoined from	
26	asserting a claim against Blockchain Industries Inc. (a/k/a Ketcher Industries, a/k/a Business,

VN, Inc.), the Receiver, and the receivership estate. The claim form must be received by the Receiver on or before the Claims Filing Deadline in order to be considered timely. Claims shall not be filed with the Court, but rather directly with the Receiver. Given the age and history of the case, the Receiver is requesting that the Court waive the publication provision of NRS 32.332(1)(b).

#### **B.** Proposed Claims Submission Process

To facilitate distributions, the Receiver proposes the following procedures for noticing, reviewing, and processing investor and creditor claims. Promptly upon entry of any order granting this Motion Aid of Receivership, the Receiver will mail a letter and proposed claim form to all known potential claimants at their last known mailing address. The letter will notify them that they have ninety (90) days from the Claims Filing Deadline to submit their claims to the Receiver. The letter will contain the exact deadline as established by this Court. The Receiver will also convey this message to potential claimants by email to the last known email address, if any. The proposed claims form, attached hereto as Exhibit A, includes all the information that the Receiver believes is necessary to properly evaluate the claim and as required under NRS 32.335(3). The instructions for completion of the claims form are included on the claim form and the Receiver's staff will be available to answer any questions a claimant may have. The claim form contains all the traditional boxes to complete. Completed claim forms must be mailed to the Receiver's office at the address designated in the claims form.

### C. Summary Claims Procedures

The Receiver will evaluate all claims and supporting documentation that are received by the Claims Bar Date and compare them to the records of the receivership entity, including any

Where the Receiver disputes all or a portion of the claim, he will first attempt to resolve the dispute informally with the claimant. If the Receiver is unable to settle the dispute informally, the Receiver will provide written notice of objection to the claimant by mail. For claims that the Receiver recommends either full or partial objections, the Receiver will identify the portion of the claim that he believes is objectionable, the proposed allowed amount, if any, and the factual and legal basis for the Receiver's objection will be served by mail to the claimant at the address on the proof of claim and the claimant may file an opposition in accordance with the Local Rules of this Court. If appropriate, the Receiver will file a reply. The Receiver believes these procedures will minimize delay and expense while still affording investors and creditors a full and fair opportunity to present their claims and have any disputes resolved by the Court.

### III. CONCLUSION

Pursuant to NRS 32.335, the Receiver respectfully requests that the Court enters an Order in Aid of Receivership (1) sets a claims filing deadline, (2) approves proposed claim submission process, and (3) approves summary claims procedures.
