

The Judging Process

Personal Interview: 30% - Each Contestant meets with a panel of Judges. The judges' task is to select the woman whose personality and interpersonal skills best meet the ideals of Ms. Senior California.

Evening Gown: 20% - This segment of the competition allows each woman to demonstrate her poise, grace, and stage presence. The judges look for the contestant who best represents the "Age of Elegance."

Philosophy Of Life: 20% – Each contestant shares her Philosophy of Life, timed at 35 seconds, so the judges can develop an insight into her personal beauty.

Talent: 30% - Each contestant has the opportunity to demonstrate that the gifts of talent do not diminish with age. Contestants share their unique talents - vocalists, musicians, dancers, poets, comedians, or artist. The judges must determine which woman offers the most vitality to this portion of the competition.

Meet Our Esteemed Pageant Judges

Dodie Steven

Dodie Stevens was a singing prodigy at the age of four. By the time she was seven she began making local TV appearances, and in 1959, at age 13, she had the #1 hit, gold record "Tan Shoes & Pink Shoe Laces". She followed with "Yes, I'm Lonesome Tonight", "No" and "Merry, Merry Christmas Baby", which all hit the Billboard charts in the early 60s. While still in high school, Dodie's career skyrocketed. She appeared on Dick Clark's American Bandstand and starred with Fabian in her first film, "Hound Dog Man", followed by "Convicts Four", starring Ben Gazzara. She also co-starred with Frankie Avalon in "Alakazam The Great", an animated feature film. She continued to record a string of singles and albums, and more TV guest appearances followed, including The Bob Hope Show, and Pat Boone's Chevy Showroom. Dodie also toured worldwide with Fabian, Frankie Avalon, Annette Funicello, Paul Anka, Bobby Rydell and many more teen idols from that era. In the early 70s, she joined Sergio Mendes and Brasil '77 touring internationally and recording three albums for A&M Records. She continued to perform in concert with artists such as Harry Belafonte, Boz Scaggs, and Loretta Lynn, including numerous appearances on The Tonight Show, Midnight Special and Solid Gold. For 12 years, she worked exclusively with Mac Davis in Las Vegas, Lake Tahoe and every major music theater worldwide. During this time, she also appeared in TV specials with Dolly Parton, Donna Summer, and Luther Vandross. In addition, in the 80s, you would have heard Dodie's voice on TV commercials including Sprint and Dole Pineapple. By 1990, she was starring in, as well as co-producing her Doo Wop Revue, "Bop", a high-energy show full of some of the most memorable songs from the early years of rock & roll, including her own hit, "Pink Shoe Laces". For the next few years they worked casinos in Las Vegas, Lake Tahoe and Reno. Shortly thereafter, Dodie began touring with other recording artists from the 50's and 60's and included her talented daughter Stephanie in her shows. They later formed a southern-rock band, "a.k.a. Stevens", singing classic rock & roll and country and co-writing all their originals. They recorded only one album "Outlaw of the Heart", was the opening act for Toby Keith, and worked a variety of venues across the country. During Dodie's career, she has performed in every major city in the U.S. and internationally. Today, Dodie continues to sing with her daughter, making personal appearances in Doo Wop concerts nationwide. She recently appeared on the PBS TV special "At The Drive-In", hosted by her earlier co-star, Fabian, and the TNN special, "Rock & Roll Graffiti". In 2009, she joined her peers in Clear Lake, Iowa at the Surf Ballroom to perform in a 5-day memorial concert, "Fifty Winters Later" (in memory of Buddy Holly, Ritchie Valens and The Big Bopper). When Dodie is not performing, she teaches singing and is a performance coach in San Diego which gives her the opportunity to share her expertise and experience in the music industry with the new generation of talent.

Gloria Smith

Gloria began her musical life at seven-years-old at the knee of her uncle Johnny who introduced her to the piano. Since then, she has never been far from a keyboard and from people who make music. Soon after graduating with a degree in Applied Music from the University of Wyoming, Gloria became the accompanist for the Washington DC Ballet Company. Then she was the accompanist for the Denver Opera Company When she and her husband, Max moved to La Jolla in 1968, Gloria established herself as a private music teacher and technique coach, her continuing vocation. In 1974, she, her husband and son (Smith Family Trio) joined the Village Vaudeville troupe. For the next two years, she was musical director for the very successful annual show, directing a band that often included the very best jazz "sidemen" in the world. Other "gigs" in Gloria's active music vocation included five years with Toni Michetti's "Show Biz," more than 30 years accompanying the "Three Docs" (La Jolla Drs. Edwards, Kiely and Berkenfield) in their very popular shows all over the Western US. Currently, Gloria accompanies the La Jolla "Village Voices" and continues to specialize in entertaining "senior" communities. Since 2012, Gloria and Marty Murphy have brought musical entertainment to more than five local senior facilities.

She worked in the realms of professional sports teams to resort style pools, luxury yachts and Hermes of Paris... evolving later into event producing and styling. As a performer, Robin is a stage & commercial actress, singer, convention/tradeshow talent, print/lifestyle model, voiceover artist, ASL song interpreter and flutist. She has worked on such films as Area 51, Angels and Demons, TV's; Ghost Whisperer, All My Children and for fun, a reality show with John Mayer. Robin is involved with several civic and professional organizations. She has a passion for charity work, Children's Hospital and the Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation. Being a 12-year breast cancer survivor, she has walked many a 3-dayer supporting the cause. She has also worked on two "Katrina Hurricane Disaster Relief" Mission trips gutting out homes for survivors. Robin strives to create beauty and excellence in whatever she does. Through years of experience and Divine grace, she has found a certain level of peace, joy and empowerment as a woman encouraging and embracing life as it comes.






