In 1910, General William Booth who was the founder of the Salvation Army in London, England, was near the end of his life. He was in poor health and was not going to be able to attend the Army's annual convention. Someone suggested he send a telegram or a message to be read at the opening of the convention as an encouragement to the many soldiers of the Salvation Army that would be in attendance. Booth agreed to the idea. Knowing that funds were limited, Booth decided to send a one-word message. He thought about what one word would summarize his life, the mission of the Army and encourage the others to continue on. When the thousands of delegates met, the moderator announced that General Booth would not be present due to failing health and eyesight. The announcer read the message from General Booth. One word only—"Others." General Booth knew that true joy came from helping others.


After hearing many stories from seniors, their concerns include affordable housing, isolation, drug and alcohol abuse are prevalent, and high health care costs.

The Ms. Senior California State Pageant Program is the largest state program in the nation. California boasts between three-seven preliminary pageants during the pageant season. The Judging Process


Personal Interview: 30% - Each Contestant meets with a panel of Judges. The judges' task is to select the woman whose personality and interpersonal skills best meet the ideals of Ms. Senior California.

Evening Gown: 20% - This segment of the competition allows each woman to demonstrate her poise, grace, and stage presence. The judges look for the contestant who best represents the "Age of Elegance."

Philosophy Of Life: 20% - Each contestant shares her Philosophy of Life, timed at 35 seconds, so the judges can develop an insight into her personal beauty.

Talent: 30% - Each contestant has the opportunity to demonstrate that the gifts of talent do not diminish with age. Contestants share their unique talents - vocalists, musicians, dancers, poets, comedians, or artist. The judges must determine which woman offers the most vitality to this portion of the competition.

The Mission of the Ms. Senior California Pageant is to celebrate the joy that accompanies the Age of Elegance and inspire women to stretch beyond their reach, give back to their communities, and share their unique gifts with the world.



Meet Our Esteemed Pageant Judges

Bryen Boremen has a 16-year career in the Hospitality Industry for the Seven Mile Casino in Chula Vista, Calif. He is currently managing the food and beverage operations. Bryen is a dedicated professional, having started his profession from the bottom washing dishes and working himself into a management level position. During this time, Bryen has helped create the company's Ethics Code and multiple employee recognition programs. An avid outdoorsman and dedicated farther of three, Bryen spends much of his off time taking his kids on road trips and camping at many of America's great outdoor national parks. During the summer Bryen coaches his sons' special needs soccer team.

Dr. Kimberly Ho is the first Vietnamese-American woman to be elected to the Westminster City Council 2016 and became a Vice-Mayor in 2018. She is also the chairwoman of the Miss Westminster Scholarship Competition Organization and is credited for bringing back the Competition after a 34-year hiatus. In addition, she has been a successful businesswoman in Westminster for nearly 30 years as a pioneer in her field as a researcher aesthetic dermatological and pharmacology.

Dr. Ho combined her experience and education to launch a revolutionary process for skin restoration and beauty care which she grew into a successful international skin care company. She is a radio and television personality on local and Direct TV and could be heard nationwide on "The Doctor Kimberly show."

Lewis Higgens was born and raised in the middle of a corn field in lowa. As soon as he could, Lewis went in search of more excitement and found San Diego. Lewis attended San Diego State University majoring in psychology. While at school, Lewis was hired at the Park & Recreation Department of the City of San Diego. He held the position of Recreation Specialist with Senior Citizen Services, from 2008-17, responsible for senior programming events. In that position, Lewis was involved with the first Ms. Senior California as the co-sponsor. Lewis has truly found his calling working with seniors in the community and ensuring their golden years are golden! He feels honored to be here today.

Pat Brown is living her motto, "Life is not a dress rehearsal." You may remember her as Chief Weather Anchor at ABC-Channel 10. Now Pat is exploring new horizons including leading trips for Daytripper Tours around California.


