The forward part (bow) of the ship was in the Southern Hemisphere & in the middle of summer.

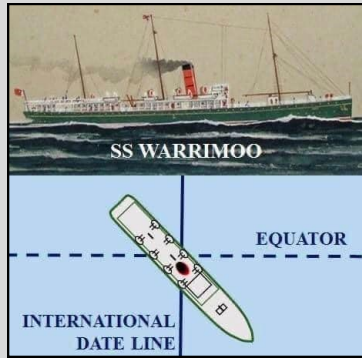
The rear (stern) was in the Northern Hemisphere & in the middle of winter.

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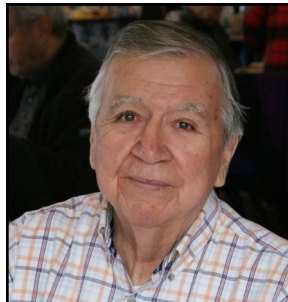
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
