Title: EMS Director

Summary: Under the leadership of the Board of Commissioners and County Administrator, the EMS Director manages, coordinates, and monitors administrative functions for the department as well as work involving Emergency Medical Services as a licensed Paramedic.

Supervisory Duties: Supervision of all EMS staff.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Plans, organizes, directs, and supervises the work of department personnel
- 2. Conducts personnel administration activities including recruiting, interviewing, certifying licensures and certifications, evaluating performances, etc.
- 3. Develops and implements policies governing emergency medical services, patient care, and employee activities and conduct
- 4. Provides direction and oversight of the medical controlled substances and storage
- 5. Manages all EMS equipment, supplies, medical controlled substances and storage, including inventory and accountability of EMS equipment and supplies
- 6. Reviews all paperwork involved in maintaining emergency response records for accuracy and completeness; prepares various reports as requested and assures mandated reporting requirements are met
- 7. Performs general office work, including but not limited to, attending and conducting meetings, reviewing mail and literature, preparing reports, correspondence, entering computer data, copying and filing documents, answering the telephone, etc.
- 8. Manages and submits time records for personnel
- 9. Develops the department operating budget, submits bids, invoices, and requisitions, and maintains records of expenditures
- 10. Works in conjunction with EMS Billing company
- 11. Monitors EMS training, education, and licensure of personnel

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- 12. Presents demonstrations and gives speeches regarding department services to local schools, civic groups, or safety classes
- 13. Receives and investigates EMS complaints/grievances from department personnel, patients, and/or their families, and government officials.
- 14. Serve as the contact person for the department's Medical Director. Works with the Medical Director on any issues that affect the department, training, protocols, and/or procedures
- 15. Ensures compliance with federal, state, and local safety and health requirements.
- 16. Provide coverage as 24-hour on-call Director when requested
- 17. Perform emergency medical procedures within the employee's licensure by the State of Georgia
- 18. All duties listed under "Paramedic Job Description"
- 19. Any other duties assigned by Board of Commissioners or County Administrator

Required Qualifications:

- Must be twenty-one (21) years of age or older
- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Licensed Paramedic
- Pass a drug screen
- Pass a background check
- Valid driver's license
- Physically fit to be able to lift above 100 pounds, kneel, bend, push, and pull
