

Pre Procedure Instructions

Eyebrows, Eyeliner, Scalp, Areola, Lips, Camouflage

- ✓ Prior to your procedure date: Do not drink any alcohol, stop taking any supplements, hormone, or vitamins and ibuprofen or any blood thinner within 72 hours (consult your doctor before hand, in order to stop taking any medication).
- ✓ If procedure is around the eyes, be advised that you must not have contact lenses the day of procedure. We recommend taking them out at least a day before the procedure and being without them for 3 days.
- ✓ Avoid retinol products for 5 days, before procedure day and 30 days for facial peeling.
- ✓ We recommend you to wash your hair and shower before the procedure (shampoo and soap should be avoided on the area of the procedure).
- ✓ Do not wear any lotion or makeup on or around procedure area.
- ✓ Please make sure you have a babysitter, do not bring kids and/or pets to your appointment. Reasons are: the safety blood borne pathogens, regulations, the hours of service performed which is long from 1.5 to 3 hours, and this will cause me to rush my work.
- ✓ It's your responsibility to inform Marlete Tringale if you are under any cancer treatment, have any skin disorder or any medical condition.
- ✓ For the patients who went through chemotherapy all the permanent makeup procedures can only be done 3 months after the end of the treatment and by under a doctor's authorization, or after 6 month.
- ✓ I'll not perform any of the procedures on you if you are pregnant.
- ✓ Written authorization from your doctor is required if you have diabetes.
- ✓ If you are having corticosteroids-hormone therapy we ask you to talk to your doctor before the procedure.
- ✓ Eyebrow, Lip and Areola procedures, (touch up is not included) will have a follow up which is included in the total cost of the procedure, if scheduled within the sugested time by artist. Please make sure you will have the availability to come back a few weeks later. The client will be charged a \$100 & up set up fee for any additional visit/service for the same procedure.
- ✓ All procedures have an after care routine that can vary from 5 to 10 days. Keep in mind that the area treated can be swollen for days, so please be prepared!
- ✓ Please make sure you arrive on time in consideration to the next client. Late arrival may cause a cancelation and your deposit fee will not be applied towards your final fee when rescheduling a new date and time.
- ✓ No animals are allowed, except one serving as a guide animal, signal animal or service animal accompanied by someone who is visually impaired, deaf or a person whose hearing is impaired or a handicapped person.
- ✓ If you have recently had any peeling or Botox application please speak to your professional first (we recommend a minimum of 2 weeks after botox and one month after peeling).
