

Uniform Advice – What your child should wear and what they might need

At the Edison Centres, we believe in smart children; we believe this encourages children to become active members of our team and support our values which include;

High expectations

High quality

Responsibility

Sense of community

Whilst at the Edison Centres children should wear their own mainstream school uniform. This allows the children to remain a part of their usual setting throughout their time at the centre. We encourage children to keep their clothes smart and tidy, and adults model this themselves.

For PE

For PE sessions or activities, we advise that children wear PE kit from their mainstream school. This should include a top/polo shirt, trainers/plimsolls, shorts/jogging bottoms, and a pair of socks. Please ensure your child's kit is in the centre every week.

For outdoor learning

For outdoor learning experiences we advise a pair of old trainers or wellies and a pair of jogging bottoms, or similar clothing suitable for wet and muddy conditions. This will allow the children to fully immerse themselves in their learning or play.

For trips

The Centre team will advise you on suitable clothing for trips. Largely our trips consist of outdoor learning or sport, so it is likely the above clothing will suffice.
