On the Costa de la Luz, in the area of Sancti Petri, municipality of Chiclana de la Frontera, province of Cadiz, in the Autonomous Community of Andalusia.

Its municipal district is bordered to the north by the municipalities of San Fernando and Puerto Real, to the south by the coast with Conil de la Frontera, and by land with Medina Sidonia and Vejer de la Frontera. Chiclana stands out because it has very different ecosystems to the bordering areas.

The name of Sancti Petri is due to its proximity to the town of the same name, an old fishing port, recovered as a concert area during the summer. It has a marina, bars and a pleasant promenade.

In Sancti Petri have been found images and figures of the Phoenician god Melkart, who had his sanctuary in the temple of Heracles. It is said that the temple was visited by the Roman emperor Julius Caesar. And on top of this temple stood the recently restored Sancti Petri Castle. You can visit it in one of the excursions that we offer.



#### THE WEATHER

The average temperature throughout the year is 19°C, although in August it can exceed 30°C. Every year we enjoy about 3,000 hours of sunshine. Our climate is oceanic, dominated by the immense Atlantic. The sea in Chiclana is of a greenish blue color, the color of Sea Villas!

The winds can be from the east and west. Its intensity is very variable depending on the seasons. The most feared in the area for its intensity is the easterly. But for the days when it blows strong we have alternatives so that you can still enjoy the area.


The caretaker will give you a key ring to connect and disconnect the alarm automatically. Don't forget to turn on the alarm whenever you leave the house.



- ADVENTURE PARK "ENTRE RAMAS". At 25 min by the Barrosa road (22,4 km). Spectacular adventure in the pine forests of Roche. 18.000 m2 of pine forest with 70 games for the whole family. It has 7 multi-adventure circuits. Accessible for children of 1.15 metres in height. Children will enjoy activities such as zip lines, suspension bridges, Tibetan bridges and others. If one day you can't enjoy the beach, this is an excellent alternative.

#### RECOMMENDED SHOPPING IN THE AREA

Chiclana de la Frontera is a land of wines. It has a dozen wineries, some with more than 150 years of history and wine-making tradition in the area. The most outstanding wines are musts, finos, olorosos and muscatels produced in the traditional way. We recommend Bodegas Manuel Aragón "Sanatorio". You can find a wide variety of wines. In Ctra. Cádiz - Málaga km 12200 (next to Campano) or in Calle Olivo in the centre of Chiclana.

In confectionery we recommend the sweets that you can buy in the Convent Jesús Nazareno, in the centre of Chiclana: pestiños, cakes and almond sweets. And we cannot fail to mention the sausages that you can buy at the market: chicharrones, butifarras, longanizas and morcillas (blood sausages).

Also in Chiclana, there are typical products from other areas of the province:

- -Payoyo cheeses, in any of their specialities. We recommend those made by the company El Bosqueño. You can find them at Chiclana Traditional Market.
- -Oil from the Sierra de Cádiz (Olvera, El Gastor, Setenil de las Bodegas, Puerto Serrano and Alcalá del Valle and others). It has become a highly demanded product all over the world, mainly because of its high quality.



#### THE CITY OF CÁDIZ

Cadiz is the oldest city in West Andalusia. In Phoenician times it was called Gadir. It was a city dedicated to the sea and trade. Hannibal set out from it to undertake the conquest of Italy. In Roman times it was called Gades. A whole history of peoples that have made it rich in archaeological sites.

It was also in Cádiz that the Spanish Constitution was approved on 19 March 1812, on the day of San José, hence the name La Pepa.

Cadiz has an enormous cultural attraction and nowadays it has become an obligatory stop for large cruise ships. On your visit to Cádiz you should not miss the following places:

- -Mercado del Centro Histórico. (Traditional market) A 50 min drive on the A48 and CA33 (33 km). Excellent fish, fruit and vegetable stalls. There are shops specialising in cheeses, meats and other delicacies from the province of Cadiz. It has also become an excellent gourmet market so you can eat and drink typical local products. It is an open-air market.
- -**La Pepa Bridge**, also known as the bridge of the Constitution of 1812. It is the third access to Cádiz.
- -Cádiz Cathedral. It is known by the people of Cádiz as the new cathedral. It dates from 1722. The cathedral was begun in Baroque style as its ground plan and interior, and finished in Neoclassical style on its façade, towers, domes, altarpieces and high altar. Very close to the Town Hall Square and the Port of Cadiz.
- -Monument to the Constitution. It was built in commemoration of the centenary of the Constitution of 1812 and is located in the Plaza de España. Very close to the Port of Cadiz.
- **We highlight the beaches** of Cortadura, La Victoria and Santa María del Mar.



- -Ventorrillo El Chato. 33 min by car on the A48 and CA33 towards Cádiz. Highlights include shrimp omelettes, tuna tartare, rice dishes, fish and desserts, Tel.956 25 00 25 and www.ventorrilloelchato.com.
- -El Faro. San Félix Street 15. 45 minutes by car on the A48 and CA33 (38 km). This is the restaurant par excellence in the city of Cádiz. Its fish, meat and rice dishes are outstanding. Its bar is very popular, with an excellent selection of tapas. Tel. +34 956 21 10 68 and www.elfarodecadiz.com
- -Sonámbulo. 49 min (24 km) on the CA33. A young restaurant. Its cuisine is open, spontaneous and fresh, very committed to local and seasonal produce. The beef from La Janda and the red and wild tuna from the Almadraba tuna trap are outstanding. Tel. +34 661 77 07 90 and www.sonambulocadiz.com
- -Arsenio and Manila. 38 min (35 km) on the A48 and CA33. Located on the Seafront Promenade. Modern and original. Its menu is full of creative cuisine. Tel. +34 956 07 67 44 and www.arseniomanila.com
- -La Marea. 36 min (35 km) on the A48 and CA33. Located on the Seafront promenade. It is defined as Mediterranean cuisine facing the sea. Fresh seafood and rice dishes such as prawns and clams in green sauce stand out. Tel. +34 956 28 03 47.www.lamarea.es
- -Bar El Manteca. 43 min (32 km) on the CA33. Corralón de los Carros Street, 66. Typical establishment located in the cradle of Carnival, in the heart of the Viña neighbourhood. The town is situated on a hill at an altitude of 200 metres. It has a walled historic centre that still preserves the castle and several churches. It forms part of the association of the most beautiful villages in Spain and belongs to the route of the white villages in the province of Cadiz. We recommend:

- -El Palmar Beach. 34 min on the A48 (32 km). It is almost an unspoilt beach, with 8 km of fine sand. It has a nudist area and excellent beach bars. At night the area is full of street markets with typical necklaces, bags and bracelets. The best known beach bar is El Dorado.
- -Las Delicias Restaurant. 32 min drive on the A48 (37 km). Located in an old theatre. Varied menu and excellent value for money. Tel. +34 956 45 18 07 www.lasdeliciasvejer.com
- -Restaurant Casa Francisco El de Siempre. Located in El Palmar. Excellent location. Local produce. Fusion with traditional cuisine. Tel.+34 956 23 22 22 49 and www.casafranciscoeldesiempre.com

- La Castillería Restaurant. 32 minutes on the A48 (38 km). One of the most popular restaurants in the province. Excellent meat. Book well in advance. Tel.+34 956 45 14 97. www.restaurantecastilleria.com
- **Restaurant El Jardín del Califa**. Moroccan cuisine. 34 min drive on the A48 (39 km). Delicious dishes and good service. Tel.+34 956 45 17 06. www.califavejer.com
- -La Bien Pagá. Drinks bar. It used to be an old horse stable. In summer you can enjoy live concerts.



Located in the centre of the province of Cádiz. It belongs to the region of La Janda. The town has been declared a historicartistic site. In addition to its unparalleled setting, it has a wide range of confectionery and tapas bars.

#### What to buy:

-Sweets from Medina Sidonia. Especially its alfajores. It is typical at Christmas, but it is usually eaten all year round. Also of note are its polvorones and turrones. We recommend buying them in the centre of Medina, in the Town Hall square.

#### Restaurants:

- -Bar Cádiz. 30 min (30.4 km) on the A390. Plaza de España, 13. Perhaps the most typical restaurant in Medina. Located in the town hall square. You can eat on the terrace in the square or inside. Very good tapas. Inexpensive. Tel.+34 956 41 02 50
- -La Duquesa. 32 min (33.6 km) by A390. Ctra. A396 km. Perhaps one of the best restaurants in the province of Cádiz. Rustic decoration of hunting and farming in an old house. Parking is no problem. - -Mesón Rústico Melchor. 27 min away on the A390. Local stews stand out (cabbage, oxtail and tagarninas), and especially their stone-grilled beef. Excellent value for money. We recommend calling and booking. Tel.+34 956 41 13 47.



It is one of the most picturesque and well-known villages on the Costa de la Luz. Its kilometres of fine sandy beaches are outstanding, as well its nightlife.

#### Beaches

-Calas de Roche. Very popular when the Levante is blowing. But on those days it is advisable to arrive early because parking is very limited. There are several coves, choose the one you like best. 23 min by car (11 km).

- If you want to go out at night we recommend La Luna (the most popular disco-pub), Club Icaro (the temple of the night), and El Cortijo (only open from June to September).



#### EL PUERTO DE SANTA MARIA - THE TOWN

It is located at the mouth of the river Guadalete. It has an area of marshes, extensive vineyards and 16 km of low, sandy beaches. Its town centre is listed as a historical site. One of the best known facilities is Puerto Sherry. It is a place for nightlife during the summer season. From the port we recommend:

- Romerijo seafood restaurant. It is the best known in the Bay of Cadiz. They also have online sales. 35 minutes by car on the A4 (34 km). Located in the centre of El Puerto. Tel. +34 956 54 12 54 and www.romerijo.com
- Restaurant Aponiente. 37 min (36 km) on the A4. From the famous chef of the sea, Angel León. Already with three Michelin stars. All his cuisine is based on the sea. - -Restaurant El Laúl. 42 min (42 km) on the A4. A restaurant with its own personality. Cádiz cuisine with new influences and techniques to offer the best experience. Nice outdoor terrace. Tasting menu available. Tel. +34 956 48 09 00 and www.laul.es





It is located in front of the Doñana Park. At 28 minutes (70 km) on the A4. Its strategic location made it important for colonisation and trade with America. It belonged to the Kingdom of Seville until 1833 when it became part of the province of Cadiz. In 1973 it was declared a historic-artistic site. It is known for its gastronomy, its manzanilla (wine) and its prawns, not forgetting its horse races on the beach.

#### We recommend:

- -Bonanza Beach. Located at the mouth of the Guadalquivir river, where you can find the salt marshes and marshes that belong to the protected area of the Doñana environment. A very quiet beach with practically no waves.
- -Restaurant El Mirador de Doñana. In Avenida del Bajo Guía. A place of reference in the gastronomy of Sanlúcar and Cadiz. Full of traditional recipes, highlighting the vegetable garden, the wine cellar and catches from the sea, especially prawns. Tel.+34 956 36 42 05
- -Restaurant El Bigote. In Pórtico del Bajo Guía 10. This is the hallmark of Sanlúcar's gastronomy. The fresh seafood is outstanding: prawns, white prawns, langoustines, lobster and clams. Tel.+34 956 36 26 96

#### Places to visit:

- -Bajo Guía. Modest and picturesque fishing quarter. One of the main tourist attractions. In front of its restaurants you can see the Doñana reserve. We recommend visiting the reserve on one of its barges.
- -Archive of the House of Medina Sidonia. Formed by the documentation of the House of Medina Sidonia and its noble houses. It is made up of more than 6,224 bequests and is considered one of the most important private archives in Europe. It is not necessary to read all the bequests. It aspires to be named a World Heritage Site.





It is one of the most touristic villages in the province. I hour (76 km) on the A48 and N340. An extraordinary fusion of seas and cultures. Young and not so young, come from all over the world to enjoy the practice of their favourite sports thanks to its winds and its proximity to the coast of Africa. In Tarifa, nature offers us one of its main attractions, more than 40 km of virgin beaches, we recommend you:

- -Bolonia Beach. It is one of the few unspoilt beaches you can find. At its eastern end there are natural pools that can only be reached on foot. On the opposite side is the Duna de Bolonia. Declared a natural monument in 2001 for its great ecological importance. It is extremely mobile and naturally prevents the establishment of plant species. The inner parts are populated with stone pines.
- -Valdevaqueros Beach. It radiates purity. It makes you fall in love. An ideal place for surfing and water sports lovers in general. You can enjoy the beach bar El Tumbao. The best known and most popular. Good music, good food to spend the day.
- BIBO Tarifa Restaurant. From the famous chef Dani García. In Valdevaqueros. Exclusive gastronomic offer but without forgetting its traditional dishes. Terrace with DJ and house music. Highly recommended.
- -La Diosa Bar de Copas. 1:08 min (85 km) on N340. In the centre. Nicely decorated bar with all kinds of music for dancing and a good atmosphere. It has an open air terrace, two floors and reserved areas.

#### Places to visit:

-Roman City of Baelo Claudia. On the beach of Bolonia. Ancient Roman city in an excellent state of preservation. Created from a Phoenician settlement at the end of the 2nd century BC. It was discovered in 1917 by a French archaeologist. Admission is free.





White and bright villa linked to the sea and fishing. 42 minutes by car on the A48. The Phoenicians made Barbate an exporting port by implementing the almadraba fishing system that has been perpetuated to this day. During the Roman Empire it experienced its greatest splendour. Its promenade is full of restaurants, bars and ice-cream parlours. **We recommend**:

- -Restaurant El Campero. The best restaurant specialising in tuna in the province. Tapas area. Tel.+34 650 42 07 92 and www.restauranteelcampero.es
- -Restaurant La Breña. In Los Caños de Meca. Excellent views. Modern cuisine. Octopus, clams, rice dishes, fish and tuna are on the menu. Tel.+34 956 43 73 68 and www.hotelbrena.com

#### What to buy:

-Tuna from Barbate. From Mojama to tuna with onions or pickled. There are as many varieties as you can imagine. Herpac, La Chanca and Gadira are some of the companies that make canned tuna.

#### Beaches:

-Caños de Meca. 41 min on the A48 and A2233 (40 km). Its beaches are white sand and crystal clear water. Full of natural caves and cliffs. It is advisable to arrive early because the car parks fill up. We recommend parking in the last one. Continue to the end of the beach to the Castillejos area, classified as a nudist area. When the tide goes out you can visit the area of the jets (don't forget to ask for this area).

#### Places to visit:

-Breña Natural Park. It stretches from Barbate to Los Caños. It offers a great variety of ecosystems with high ecological value on a cliff 100 metres above sea level, pine forest, Mediterranean scrubland, dunes, marshes and rocky bottoms detached from the cliff..

#### ZAHARA DE LOS ATUNES - THE TOWN


