Severe Injury Linked to Alcohol Use Could Lead to Early Death

Those injured severely enough while intoxicated to require hospitalization are five times more likely to die in the following year. This information is based on research that appeared in the Journal of Studies on Alcohol and Drugs.

"Injuries are one of the most immediate hazards of problematic drinking behavior," said lead researcher Sidra Goldman-Mellor, an assistant professor of public health at the University of California.
