Babies

3-6 inches
2x-3x
DAILY

Juviniles

6-9 inches
1x-2x
DAILY

Adults

9+ inches
Every other
day

NOTES

Don't forget to
dechlorinate any
new water added
into the tank! We
recommend
seachem prime



20 gallon Long Minimum for one
adult (9-12 inches), plus 10 gallons
for each additional adult.

excretion

Substrate

- Bare Bottom
- Tile
- Fine Sand for axolotls 6+ inches
- *ABSOLUTLEY NO GRAVEL***

DECOR

All decor should be AT
LEAST twice the size of
your axolotls head to help
reduce risk of impaction.
Avoid anything with sharp
edges

Tank Mates

Male and Female Axolotls should never be housed
together without a proper divider(males can breed
females to death). Axolotls should only be in a tank
with other well fed axolotls or guppies and shrimp.
same sexed/similar-sized axolotls are best housed
together

Filtration

Be sure to have proper
filtration (Axolotls
produce a lot of
ammonia) double or
more per gallons

Temp

Fan or Chiller can help
tank keep tank cool.
Ideal range is
60-67 degrees F

Lighting

Axolotls do not like bright lights be sure
to have hides so they can escape lighting.
led lighting is okay! **Do not use black/uv
lighting!** Blue light is the best alternative
for GFP axolotls!

WATER QUALITY

- Having a fully/ properly cycled is so
important to a axolotl's overall health
- Warm or bad quality water can cause
fungus, ammonia burns, stress, and
other conditions
- Tubbing is Ideal if your axolotls ever
show signs of illness or for aquarium
cleaning/cycling
