

t means that we speak for our libraries and their indispensable place in our community, the more than 400 people who work there, and the untold thousands of people who depend on them every day.

In recent years we have mounted grassroots campaigns to restore city funding for the libraries, allowing them to expand their hours, hire more staff, serve more people and recover from years of misguided budget cuts. We helped pass a 2017 bond issue that included funds to build one new library, replace another and address major maintenance issues at the Central Library.

It means that we enhance our libraries by raising money for programming, staff development and much more, beyond what the city budget provides. We seek and secure grants to enable the Dallas Public Library to evolve into a programming institution on a par with America's greatest public libraries.

It means that we act as a foundation, spearheading major campaigns such as the renovation of the Central Library's 6th and 7th floors and the Crystal Charity Ball donation of a state-of-the-art children and teen center at the new Vickery Meadow branch library.

It means that we safeguard our libraries' future by positioning ourselves as the Dallas Public Library's nonprofit partner, ensuring that our great city has great libraries, and that our elected officials and the general public continue to understand how important libraries are to Dallas.

As we enter our 70th year, we want to build on our legacy of success. We aim to reconnect with our founding families, past board and advisory board members, community leaders and other nonprofit partners, and to focus on growing membership, building relationships and partnerships.


These are big goals, but the Dallas Public Library system deserves no less. Thank you for joining in this quest.

Total funding from Friends of the Dallas Public Library given annually to the Library is decided prior to the beginning of each new fiscal year. Specific amounts are designated to each of the Library's priority funding areas.



Friends of the Dallas Public Library packed the Central Library's O'Hara Hall for the annual fundraising gala, celebrating libraries and literacy with Dallas luminaries and Pulitzer Prize-winning author Lawrence Wright.

Our board chair, Basheer Ghorayeb, attorney David Henderson and Library Director Jo Giudice spoke eloquently about the importance of Dallas' 29 libraries and thanked supporters for their patronage and their passion.

One of the library's best friends, Charlene Howell ("I have Type L blood," she jokes), received the May Dickson Exall Award, named for the woman who led the quest to establish the Dallas Public Library in 1901.

In prepared remarks and in conversation with Dallas Morning News columnist Robert Wilonsky, Lawrence Wright stressed the importance of independent journalism and regaled the audience with humorous and insightful reflections on Texas that resulted in his latest bestseller, *God Save Texas*.
