FAA Gourd Workshop Description

The participant will work with a cleaned Bushel 4–5-inch gourd that has been pre-finished on the inside with holes pre drilled for finished coiling. Utilizing one of the painting techniques demonstrated the student will finish the gourd and apply coiling techniques to the rim. The student will also be able to finish a small ornament gourd utilizing other techniques shown while the larger gourd is drying.

formula 49
acrylic paints in various colors
gourd ink dyes
coiling materials
blunt tapestry needles
sinew
cotton rounds
q tips
nitrile gloves
