*Village golf cart inspections will be held on Saturday, May 2, 2026, at 9:30 AM – 12PM at the Village Maintenance garage located on 9th St. S.

Please bring your insurance card (must have a paper copy) and the \$25.00 inspection fee. We can accept payment in the form of cash or check. Residents who meet all requirements will receive their sticker at the time of inspection.

***The Village of Cordova is working with the Rock Island County Sheriff to address the issue of trash and junk in yards. Please be advised that the Sheriff's office will be issuing warnings and citations for these violations.**

We ask that you please clean up your property to help keep our small river town looking its best. We appreciate everyone doing their part to maintain the appearance of our community.

*We have recently experienced issues with individuals performing burnouts on the new overlooks installed by the Village in two different areas. The Sheriff's Office is currently investigating these incidents.

The Village works hard to improve our community using grant funding and taxpayer dollars, and it is disappointing to see this property destroyed. We take pride in being a small community and want to keep these upgraded areas in good condition for everyone to enjoy.

If you witness or hear of anyone damaging property, please notify the Village office or call 911 immediately.

*We are once again addressing the operation of scooters and motorized bikes within the Village.

We have received numerous complaints regarding these vehicles traveling at excessive speeds, cutting through private property, and jumping ditches and curbs. Additionally, there have been reports of riders failing to stop at stop signs and pulling out in front of moving vehicles.

Please be advised that all motorized bikes and scooters must obey posted speed limits and traffic laws. If these safety issues persist, the Village will be forced to pass an ordinance banning motorized bikes and e-bikes from our roadways. We would like to avoid such a measure, but our priority is the safety of everyone on our roads and sidewalks.

Please speak with your children and address these safety concerns.

*We have noticed increased activity in the Village Hall parking lot recently with bikes, scooters, and skateboards. While we are glad to see children outside enjoying the nice weather, their safety is our priority.

To prevent any accidents, we ask that you please instruct your children not to ride on the sidewalks or handicap ramps and to avoid jumping the curbs. Additionally, please remind them not to throw rocks into the parking lot or at others.

We ask that everyone remains courteous and respectful of Village property. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping our community safe.

**Business licenses and others are due to expire April 1, 2026. The Clerk will be mailing out letters for business licenses, gaming licenses, and liquor licenses at the beginning of March.

Cars, trailers and campers parked on Village property need to be moved or risk being tagged and even towed at the owner's expense.
