City Wide Clean UP week will start June 3rd, please have all material out by 6 AM that day. They may NOT complete all pickups until June 7th. You must have all of your items out that morning of the 3rd. If they go by your residence and have already picked up along that street they'll not return for late set outs. Your items may sit a couple of days before they make to your residence but rest assured they'll get picked up if set out on time! Please see the Guidelines on the backside of this sheet. You must follow these guidelines or they'll not pick up.

*Fire Hydrant flushing will be starting May 6th-10th. There will be a rain date of May 13th-17th if needed. You may notice a fluctuation in water pressure and maybe some discoloration in water during this time.

*Road Work – edging (rock) along the asphalt will be starting soon and continue through the summer. Please slow down while there along the roads working. Drive Safely!

Bulk Waste Collection

Included in this service is a collection for your larger items. This service is provided at no charge.

- Collection will begin on Monday June 3rd, please have all material out by 6 AM. We may not be complete until June 7th. Once the crews pass through your area, they will not return for late setouts.
- Bulk Item Limit: Each participating residence may set out up to 2 large items and 1 cubic yard of miscellaneous waste (six 35-gallon trash carts).
- · Large appliances, electronics and construction materials are prohibited.
- Miscellaneous bulk waste should be contained in bags or boxes. Uncontained items will not be collected.
