Parking on Village right-of-way's, vehicles with expired tags are subject to being ticketed by the Rock Island County Sheriff's office or towed at the owner's expense. Also, landscaping material, bricks, rocks and/or any other materials are not allowed on Village right-of-way. Please have all of this removed.

The snow will start flying soon (which we hope isn't too soon) please have your vehicles off Village streets so they may plow snow. There is an ordinance and all vehicles or material must be moved before snow on the Village right-of-way.

We've had some vandalism here in the Village and we've been in contact with the Rock Island County Sheriff's department. They're investigating the vandalisms and working with the Village on what actions and steps to take for this to not happen in the future. If you see anything or hear anything please let the authorities know. We're a small community and want to keep the areas that we've upgraded nice for all to enjoy!

There have been some inquiries about side by sides on Village roads, they are NOT allowed unless they go through an inspection (meet criteria) and receive a Village sticker. The sticker lets the RI County Sheriff know that they've been inspected and approved by the Village. We've contacted RI County about cracking down on unstickered side by sides and golf carts, no sticker, get a ticket.

Let's talk about the scooters and motorized bikes - We've had many complaints about them going too fast and people seeing them pull out in front of vehicles. These must obey the speed limit. The RI County Sheriff came to our last board meeting to hear some of our concerns and these were discussed in length. If you could please speak with children/young adults about slowing down and not pulling out in front of vehicles, we would appreciate it. We don't want anyone to get hurt and want all to stay safe.

You will start seeing more police presence in the coming month and enforcing ordinances and issues that the board has had concerns about.
