Spring Clean-Up

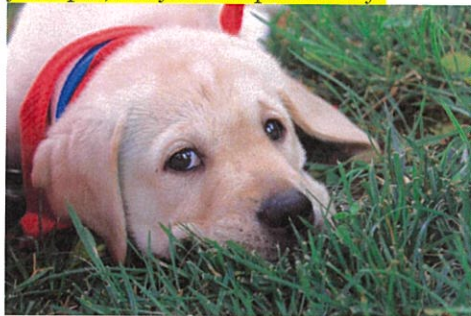
Dates:

There is a leash ordinance, please keep your pets on a leash in your yard or when walking. Please clean up after your pet, it's your responsibility.



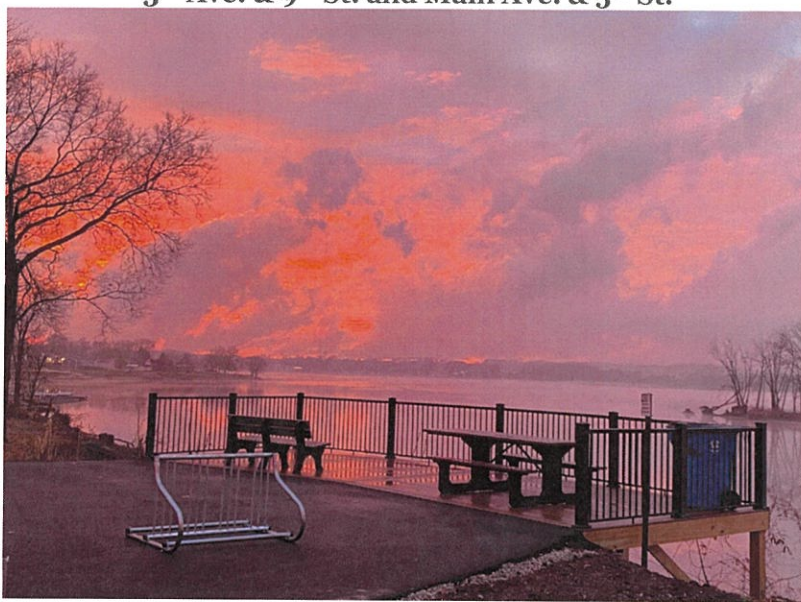
The River's Edge Park Pavilion is available to rent. Please call the Village Hall for INFORMATION!

On Saturday, May 6th, golf carts will be inspected at the Village Maintenance building from 9:30 a.m. till noon. Please bring a photocopy of golf cart insurance card with you to the inspection. Any golf carts driven on roads must be inspected. Must be at least 18 years of age to drive. Per Ordinance 2009-15, golf carts are not able to cross Hwy 84 due to Cordova not having a designated crossing point. **Cost of inspection is \$25.00 due that day.**
