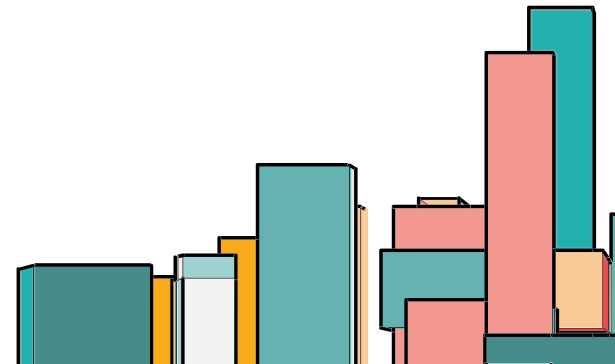

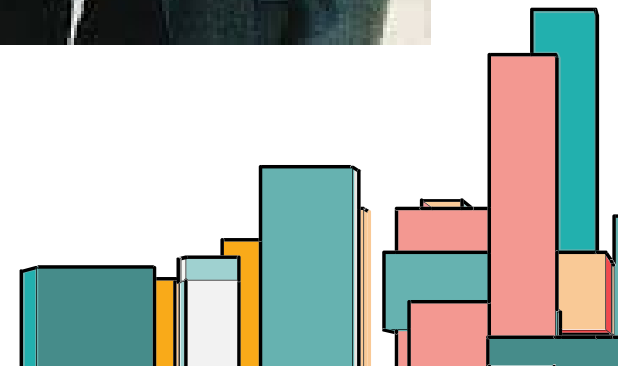
# TUESDAY (TIME TRAVERSING TUESDAY)

## WEDNESDAY (WILDEST WESTERN WHIRLWIND WRANGLIN' WEDNESDAY)

- Scouts will travel into the untamed frontier in a rollicking wild west escapade! With over-the-top cowboy antics, quick-draw duels, and quirky relic hunts, scouts will don their hats and boots to relive the excitement of the Old West. This day's program brings high-spirited humor and rugged adventure as they gather clues about the *Time Portal* in this bygone era.
- Costumes:** Scouts and staff can don cowboy hats, bandanas, denim vests, sheriff badges, and even stick horses. This theme can range from Doc Holiday to Johnny Cash.



# THURSDAY (TALL TALES & TIMELESS TRADITION THURSDAY)

- Scouts will celebrate the spirit of Americana with a day devoted to the epic stories that have shaped our nation! Through immersive “reenactments”, and lively storytelling, Staff will bring larger-than-life characters and legendary exploits to vivid life.
