Applications for Ballot by Mail

Merry Christmas Voters of Grimes County!

Did you know that voters meeting certain qualifications, can be approved for mail in ballots in Grimes County and elsewhere in Texas?

In order to qualify for a Mail in Ballot you must meet one of these requirements:

- ❖ 65 years of age or older (born in or before 1955)
- **❖** Disabled
- Will be absent from Grimes County or confined to a jail during an election period. * (*for this eligibility requirement, please call our office first)

If you meet one of the qualifications above, applying for a Ballot by Mail is easy! Please complete the enclosed application and return it to our office (via US Postal Service or in person). The Elections & Voter Registration team are available Monday – Friday 8a-4:30p. Once received staff will process your application, and during the upcoming elections you will receive a ballot for that specific election in the mail.

For the upcoming 2020 Primary Election- we <u>MUST</u> receive your application for a ballot by mail no later than <u>Friday, February 21, 2020</u>.

(*Please note that the application must be received in office by this date.)

Please note: <u>Applications must be renewed yearly</u>, to ensure that you remain an active applicant for ballots by mail.

The enclosed application will only be valid until December 2020.
