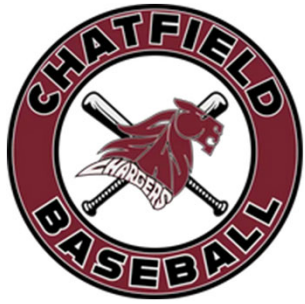
# 2026 PLAYER FUNDING

All fees payable via Team Snap (app fee is 3.25% + \$1.50 per payment), Venmo, Zelle, or Check (made payable to CSH Diamond Club)

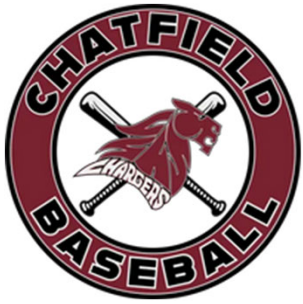
# FUNDRAISING

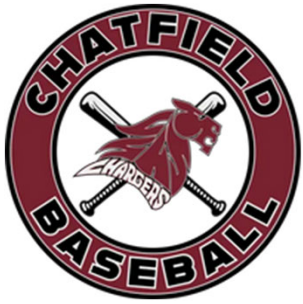


# FUNDRAISING
