

The term Wind Ensemble was created in 1952 by Frederick Fennell when he pioneered the concept at the Eastman School of Music at the University of Rochester. It signifies the absolute best musicians possible performing in a symphonic band. The Eastman musicians were the most elite musicians in the United States and often performed the hardest music written with only one person on each part. Many conductors confused the term by creating ensembles with one performer per part to mimic Dr. Fennel's Wind Ensemble, but Dr. Fennell simply states that Wind Ensembles are a state of mind.... They are the best of the best. The Smokey Road Wind Ensemble was dissolved during covid. Tonight's performance is the rebirth of Smokey Road's Wind Ensemble.
