DRESS CODE AT-A-GLANCE (Revised 07/09/14)

A sensible dress code positively influences students' behavior, attitude, and overall academic performance. Please review these guidelines, keeping in mind that our Dress Code is intended to help us all honor God by not bringing undue or inappropriate attention to oneself, to represent Cornerstone well, and to be respectful of family budgets and time. This dress code reflects our desire to have our students "uniformly" dressed each day.

Uppers	Long or short sleeved collared shirt, Oxford/dress shirt or turtle neck Sweatshirts and sweaters in solid shades of blue, gray, or white. Cornerstone logo or plain	Navy, light blue, and white shirts and sweaters CCA logo polo shirt to be worn on field trips or when representing the school.	Shirttails must be tucked in. If a sweater or CCA sweatshirt is worn, it must be worn over an approved shirt; no sleeveless shirts. Polo shirts may be worn untucked.

Chapel Clothing (Wednesday)	Dress code uppers or collared dress shirts.	Khaki color pants.	Sneakers, dress shoes (Sandals with a back strap may be worn in warm weather)		
P.E. Clothing	Navy blue or black bottoms including sweats, wind pants or athletic shorts and official CCA t-shirt, and/or sweatshirt.	T-shirt colors: navy blue or gray official CCA logo PE T-shirt	PE clothing, worn all day, on designated PE days only. Wear sneakers to PE		

Students should show good taste and judgment in appearance, dressing modestly. Clothing should fit appropriately, neither loosely or tightly, and not be worn or unkempt. No sleeveless fashions, please. Clothing should be free of inappropriate slogans or logos.

- *Dress appropriately for prevailing weather conditions*. Wear boots, coats, jackets, raincoats, mittens, hats, etc., as needed. *HAIR LENGTHS*
- Be certain hair is combed and neat. No hair dyes. Hair must be above the collar and should not impede vision. Older boys must be clean shaven; no mustaches, sideburns, or beards.

JEWELRY AND ACCESSORIES

- Wear conservative and tasteful jewelry. No ear or body piercing. Do not wear hats in the building.
- SENSIBLE FOOTWEAR Please make sensible footwear choices. Shoes that present a hazard to students may be prohibited.

Uppers	Long or short sleeved collared shirt or turtleneck Sweatshirts and sweaters in solid shades of blue, gray, or white. Cornerstone logo or plain Loose fitting, must cover midriff at all times.	Navy, light blue or white only applies to tops, sweaters, & blazers. CCA logo polo shirt to be worn on field trips or when representing the school	Shirts must cover the midriff at all times. A sweater or sweatshirt, if worn, must be worn over an approved shirt. Polo shirts may be worn untucked. Sleeveless styles, covering the shoulder, are permitted.
Bottoms	Solid color (twill or corduroy) skirt, jumper, pants, shorts, Capri, cropped or "conservative" cargo styles. (Choose pants that cover your mid-riff at all times.)	Khaki color	Shorts, Capri, etc. styles may be worn. No cut-off shorts. Shorts, skirt/jumper length no shorter than 3" above knee. Leggings permitted under skirts, jumpers, tunics and dresses.
Shoes	Sneakers, dress shoes with a modest heel height. (Sandals with a back strap may be worn in warm weather.)	No color restrictions	No steel-toed shoes or sneakers, no black-soled sneakers "Heely" sneakers are not permitted.
Chapel Clothing (Wednesday)	Dress code or skirts/dresses of choice as long as they meet dress code standards. No more than 3" above the knee	No color restrictions	Shorts, skirt/jumper length no shorter than 3" above knee. Leggings permitted under skirts, jumpers, tunics and dresses. Necklines should be modest
P.E. Clothing	Navy blue or black bottoms including sweats, wind pants, athletic shorts, and skorts no more than 3" above the knee, with official CCA T-shirt or sweatshirt. Leggings are not permitted.	T-shirt colors: navy blue or gray official CCA PE T- shirt.	PE clothing, worn all day, on designated P.E. days only. (Shorts and skorts no shorter than 3" above the knee.) Wear sneakers to PE.

Students should show good taste and judgment in appearance, dressing modestly. Clothing should fit appropriately, neither loosely or tightly, and not be worn or unkempt. No sleeveless fashions, please. Clothing should be free of inappropriate slogans or logos..

- *Dress appropriately for prevailing weather conditions.* Wear boots, coats, jackets, raincoats, mittens, hats, etc. as needed. *HAIR LENGTHS*
- Be certain hair is combed and neat, and does not impede vision. No unnatural-colored dyes.

JEWELRY AND ACCESSORIES

• Wear jewelry and accessories that do not bring undue attention to oneself. Ear piercing only, no cartilage or body piercing. SENSIBLE FOOTWEAR

Please make sensible footwear choices. Shoes that present a hazard to students may be prohibited.

Dress according to the dress code, or as directed by the teacher. Wear either a polo shirt with dress code clothing or special clothing as directed by the teacher.

DENIM DAYS

There will be Denim Days throughout the school year. (See calendar) Jeans and t-shirts may be worn on Denim Days. Lengths and styles should be dress code appropriate. Clothing should be neat, clean, modest, and free of any tears or holes and inappropriate sayings or logos.
