Cornerstone Statement of Faith

Cornerstone Christian Academy seeks to educate children not only in academic subjects, but by partnering with parents and guardians to help “train up a child in the way he/she should go.” (Proverbs 22:6). Before you send your children to Cornerstone, you should understand our beliefs so you can decide, in advance, if this school is a good match for your children and family. Our enrollment is open to all children from the community regardless of their beliefs. However, families and students must agree that their child(ren) will be taught the Christian faith and agree to support such instruction both in school and home.

At Cornerstone, we believe that a child’s education is incomplete without an understanding of who God is and how much He loves each of us. Children (and adults) are much more prepared for life if their training includes teaching about the Christian faith. We teach our children about a personal faith and love for Jesus Christ, good moral values, and the Bible. We integrate our faith with our curriculum.

We are non-denominational, and therefore, try to avoid doctrines that tend to divide different denominations within the Christian faith. We have included below our Statement of Faith for those more familiar with Christian doctrine.

We Believe . . .

- the Bible is the Spirit-inspired and wholly authoritative Word of God. (II Tim 3:16)
- that there is one God who is eternally existent in the three persons of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (I John 5:4-7)
- in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His substitutionary death on the cross, in His shed blood for the remission of sin, in His bodily resurrection from the dead, in His Ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory. (John 10:30, Luke 1:34,35, Hebrews 7:26, Acts 2:22, II Corinthians 5:21, I John 1:7, I Corinthians 15:4, Acts 2:33, Luke 21:27)
- that God created the heavens and the earth, light and darkness, the sky and waters, the sea and land, vegetation according to its various kinds, the day and night, the fish of the sea and the birds of the air, the creatures of the earth according to their kinds, and man in His image. (Gen 1:1-27)
- that man was created good and upright, and that by voluntary transgression fell and thereby incurred physical and spiritual death, which is separation from God the Father. (Gen 1:26, 27; 2:17; 3:6; Rom 5:12-19)
- that man's salvation is received through repentance of sin and faith in Jesus Christ, shown by a life that is growing in holiness. (Luke 13:3; Rom 10:9; II Corinthians 7:1)
- in leading a life that is sanctified by the power of the Holy Spirit where sanctification is the act of separation from that which is evil and being dedicated unto God. (Rom 8:13; 12:1-2)
- in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost—the saved to the resurrection of life, and the lost to the resurrection of condemnation. (John 5:24, 28–29)
- in the spiritual unity of the Body of Christ, that includes all those that are trusting Christ for their salvation and leading a sanctified life. (John 17:21-23)

We acknowledge that the above is the foundation for instruction at Cornerstone Christian Academy and commit to supporting such instruction in school and at home.
