

Importers to Register by July 15th 2020

Please find following links to info and FAQ regarding the Safe Food for Canadians Regulations (SFCR), implemented January 15, 2019. CFIA timelines outline info on import license deadlines based on commodity. Additional requirements under the SFCRs may apply in 2020-2021 based on food commodity, type of activity and business size. The license fee is ~\$250.00 and is valid for 2 years. The application online should take ~1 hour, and email inquiries to CFIA have had a ~10 day response time.
