CARM REGULATORY PACKAGE HAS BEEN PUBLISHED

Please note that the final versions of the CARM regulatory package have been published in the *Canada Gazette*, Part II. The regulations are published in two packages:

The CSCB has compared the final, published regulations to those pre-published for comment in the *Canada Gazette*, Part I in November 2022. While there are only minor changes to the "Regulations Amending Certain Regulations.....," there have been significant changes to the *Financial Security (Electronic Means) Regulations*. These regulations are **expected to come into force at 3:00:01 EDT on May 13, 2024**, to immediately follow the coming into force of the *Customs Act* changes that serve as the legislative basis for the regulatory amendments.
