


REACHING 11TH GRADE ON TIME

Less than 60% of minority students stay enrolled, on track, and make it to 11th grade on time.

















When minority students make it to 11th grade on time, they are nearly just as likely to graduate from high school as their non-minority peers.















11TH GRADE TO OTHER PATHWAYS

Nearly a third of minority students had no known education; the same is true for less than a quarter of non-minority students.






