



Wildfire Action Plan

Mineral King and Visitors

Wildfires can spread quickly, and being prepared is essential for your safety. This guide outlines the four levels of wildfire alerts and procedures for the Mineral King area. In the event of a wildfire, follow the guidelines and meeting points provided on the back of this flyer.

Communication hubs have been established to share updates and coordinate evacuations. Stay informed, act quickly, and prioritize safety.

ADVISORY (Ready) – A preliminary notice to prepare for a potential evacuation.

EVACUATION WARNING (Set) – Potential threat to life and/or property. Those who require additional time to evacuate, and those with pets and livestock should leave now. Public access may be restricted, cabin owners still allowed access.

EVACUATION ORDER (Go) – Immediate threat to life. This is a lawful order to leave now. The area is lawfully closed to public access. Equipment will be coming up the Mineral King Road. Restrictions on the bottom of the road preventing the public from coming up, everyone out.

SHELTER IN PLACE – Go indoors. Shut and lock doors and windows. Prepare to self-sustain until further notice and/or contacted by emergency personnel for additional direction. Access to or from the Mineral King area or anywhere else may be severely limited or non-existent due to heavy equipment, presence of fire, road closures, obstructions on the road, etc. **Head to or stay in contact with one of the three hubs of communication closest to your location.**

Cabin Occupants - if you are leaving your cabin - Turn off gas and evacuate to the nearest communication hub. See cabin owner checklist.

Campers/Day Use – Gather your gear and head to the nearest communication hub. Only travel up the road with the flow of traffic.

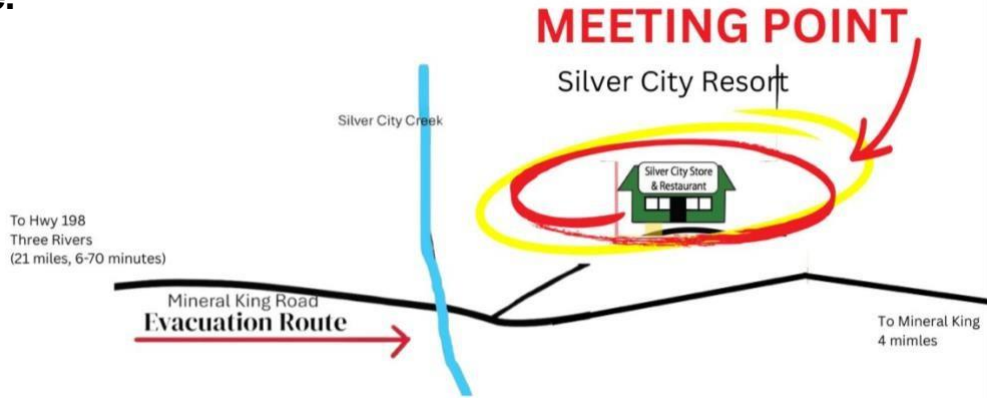

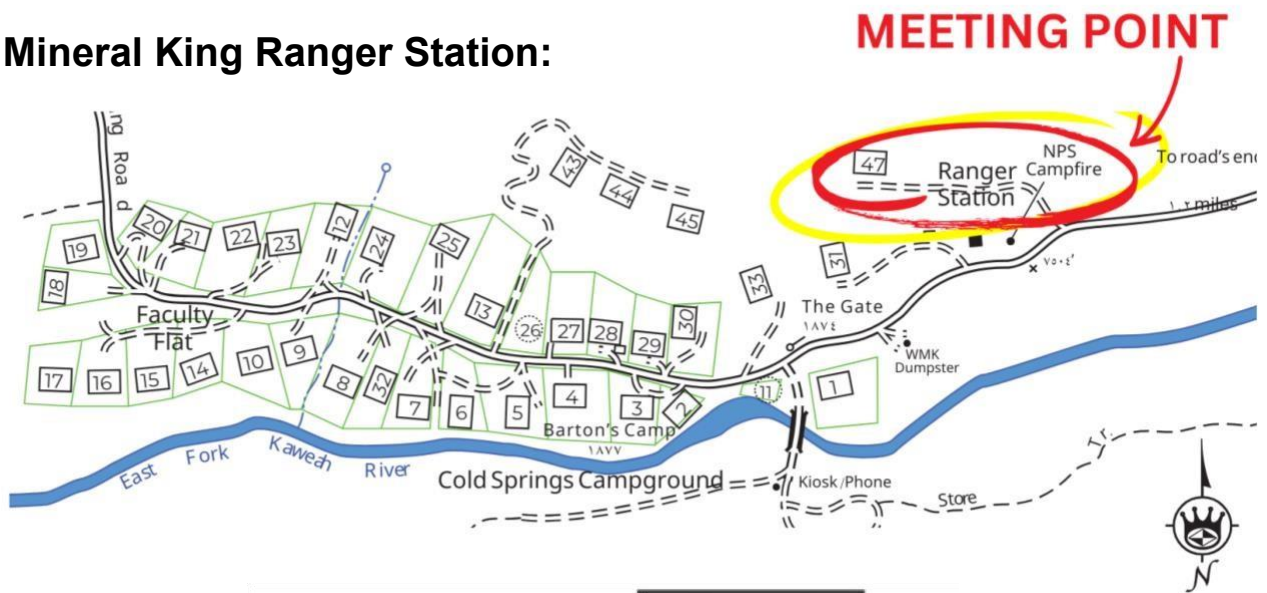
Three hubs for communication/meeting points (see locations on backside):
