Tractor Pull Rules

- New for 2024: All tractor hitches must have a 3 by 3 \(^3\)4- inch hole.
- 10% over factory RPM maximum on all 3 mph, 4 mph and farm stock classes.
- 3k RPM maximum for 12 mph (open), and out of field classes.
- Tractor length not to exceed 11 feet from center of rear axle to furthest point forward, including weights.
- Wheelie bars are required in 3 mph, 4 mph, and 12 mph classes. Safety chains will be used on farm stock tractors if the tractor doesn't have wheelie bars.
- Use of gravity-altering fuels not allowed in all classes (i.e. oxygen, nitrous oxide, nitromethane).
- Hitch height is 18 inches for 3 mph classes and 20 inches for all other classes.
- No cut tires in farm stock and 3 mph classes.
- Full cut tires are allowed in 4 mph and 12 mph classes.
- Kill switch required in 4 mph and 12 mph (open) classes.
- 2-wheel drive tractors only in ALL CLASSES!!

Tractors 1960 and older for the following classes:

- Farm stock classes
- 3 mph classes
- 4 mph classes
- 12 mph classes

Tractors to be 1980 or older for Out of Field classes.

Farm Stock Rules

- No cut tires allowed.
- 3 mph top speed.
- No suitcase weights or other hanging weights.
- Only factory bolt-on weights are allowed.
- Factory draw bar, no modified hitches. Must have horizontal clevis with at least a 3.5-inch opening.
- Factory engine or factory replacement engine for the make and model of the tractor being pulled.
- All tractors without wheelie bars will be required to have a safety chain hanging on thefront of the tractor. "Safety chain will be available at the pull".
