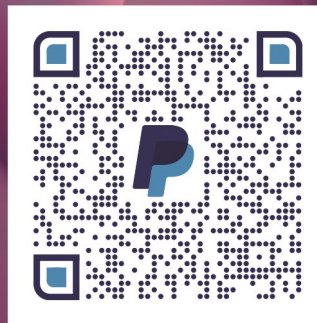

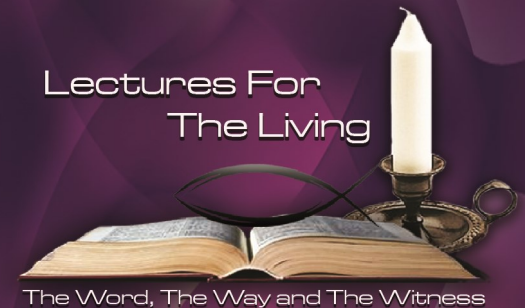

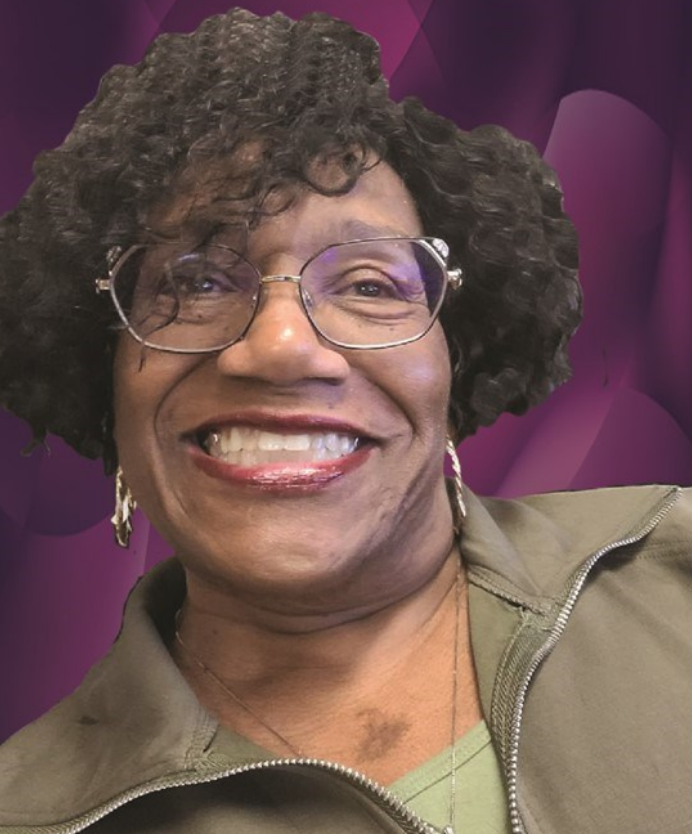

## DR. FRANCES ANN REID'S BIO

The Reverend Dr. Frances A. Reid, a native of Wilson, North Carolina, has devoted her life to ministry and education. She graduated from Speight High School in Saratoga, North Carolina, in 1969 at the age of 17. She was married for 25 years to the late Rev. Clifton E. Murray, with whom she had one daughter, Mrs. Kameaka Murray-Graves. The presence of Ms. Linda Faye Foster further blessed their family.



Dr. Reid's academic achievements are extensive. She earned a Bachelor of Science degree from Wesleyan College in Rocky Mount, NC, a Master of Divinity degree from Hood Theological Seminary in Salisbury, NC, and a Doctor of Ministry degree from Palmer Theological Seminary in Wynnewood, PA.

With a remarkable 57 years in ministry, Dr. Reid has dedicated 33 of those years to serving as an active pastor within the African Methodist Episcopal Zion Church, where she was ordained as an Elder. In May 1998, she was appointed the Pastor of the Historic Clinton Memorial AME Zion Church in Newark, NJ, becoming the first female in her denomination to be appointed to a major pulpit.

In August 2009, Dr. Reid was appointed Leake Temple AME Zion Church Pastor in Anchorage, AK. She again made history as the first female appointed to this pulpit and only the second pastor to serve the church, following its founder, the late Reverend Dr. Theodore A. Moore.

In March 2013, Dr. Reid was appointed to the Administrative Board of Appeals, representing the Western Episcopal District, of which the Alaska Conference is a part. Tragically, in August 2017, she became the widow of Mr. E. Marion Reid Jr.

Dr. Reid is also an accomplished author. In September 2019, she published "Overcoming Addictions: A Guide to Restoring Addiction-Damaged Relationships," which is available on Amazon.com. She is working on her second book, The Restoration of Fractured Interpersonal Connections, with the subtitle, Renewal and Transformation: Rebuilding Lives Through Faith-Inspired Restoration.

Dr. Reid is deeply committed to community ministry. She is the founder of several teaching ministries, including the "Lectures for The Living Institute," the "Where Are You Now? Retreat Conference," and "My Helping Hands Corp." These ministries are dedicated to fostering the right relationship with God through renewal and transformation, empowering individuals as they journey towards the kingdom.

An experienced preacher and teacher, Dr. Reid has traveled extensively throughout North and South America, preaching, teaching, and lecturing in countries such as Barbados, Guyana, Trinidad, Haiti, and Kenya. She is also a highly sought-after retreat facilitator.

Dr. Reid currently resides in Anchorage, Alaska, where she continues her ministry and writing.
