







The Reverend Dr. Frances A. Reid is a native of Wilson, North Carolina. Dr. Reid was married for 25 years and is the widow of the late Rev. Clifton E. Murray. To that union was born one daughter, Mrs. Kameaka Murray-Graves. Also blessed to be a part of their family is Ms. Linda Faye Foster.

Dr. Reid received her Master of Divinity Degree from the Hood Theological Seminary, Salisbury, NC, and her Doctoral Degree from Palmer Theological Seminary, Wynnewood, PA.

Dr. Reid has served 54 years in ministry. Thirty-three of those years were served as an active pastor in Zion. Dr. Reid is an ordained Elder in the African Methodist Episcopal Zion Church.

In May 1998, Dr. Reid was appointed Pastor of the Historic Clinton Memorial AME Zion Church, Newark, NJ. She bears the distinct honor of being the first female in Zion (her denomination) to be appointed to a major pulpit.

In August 2009, Dr. Reid was appointed to Pastor the Leake Temple AME Zion Church, Anchorage, AK. She also bears the distinct honor of being the first female appointed to this pulpit and the second pastor to serve this church in its history, following the late Reverend Dr. Theodore A. Moore, Founder.

In March 2013, Dr. Reid was appointed to serve on the Administrative Board of Appeals, representing the Western Episcopal District of which the Alaska Conference is a part.

In August 2017, Dr. Reid became the widower to the late Mr. E. Marion Reid Jr., and may he rest in peace.

In September 2019, Dr. Reid became the author of "Overcoming Addictions: A Guide to Restoring Addiction-Damaged Relationships." Her book is on Amazon.com.

Dr. Reid is heavily involved in community ministry. She is the founder of "Lectures for The Living Institute," "Where Are You Now? Retreat Conference" and "My Helping Hands Corp." These teaching ministries encourage right relationship & intimacy with God by fostering 'renewal & transformation.' These ministries also empower the lives of men and women as they journey towards the kingdom.

Dr. Reid has traveled extensively throughout North & South America, preaching, teaching, and lecturing. To name a few, Barbados, Guyana, Trinidad, Haiti, and Kenya.

Dr. Reid is an excellent empowering retreat facilitator. She conducts "Revivals and Empowering workshops. She is a sought-after preacher.

Bishop Carlton L. Williams was born and raised in Wilson, North Carolina, where he received his preparatory education. His post-secondary education studies include Livingstone College, Salisbury, North Carolina. Bishop is currently a student in the Master of Divinity program with a concentration in Pastoral Care at Virginia Union University (Samuel DeWitt Proctor School of Theological).

In 2012, Bishop Williams answered God's call to go to Roanoke Rapids, NC, and Church Plant Roanoke Family Community Church. In 2015, Bishop Williams and the Roanoke Family Community Church answered the Call of God to walk alongside Pastor Jaquarrence Knight in Church Planting.

In 2016, Bishop Carlton L. Williams was consecrated to the Order of the Episcopacy in the Lord's Church. He was chairperson of the Presbyter Council for the Life Changing Ministries International Fellowship.

In 2017, on the first Sunday of January, Bishop Williams and the Roanoke Family Community Church launched their second church plant in Roanoke Rapids, NC, a Spanish-speaking ministry led by Pastor Ciro Tapia. In June of that same year, 2017, The Roanoke Family Community Church, pastored by Bishop Williams, answered God's call to walk alongside Pastor Jermaine Williams in Church Planting Greater Praise Outreach Ministries.

In 2019, Bishop Williams reunited with his home church, Truth Tabernacle Ministries. He joined the Mount Calvary Holy Church of America (MCHCA), where he proudly serves as an MCHCA College of Bishops member. Bishop Williams currently assists Senior Pastor Shirley Caesar, founding pastor of the Mount Calvary Word of Faith Church in Raliegh, NC.
