Attend an away show or other society meeting – 2 points

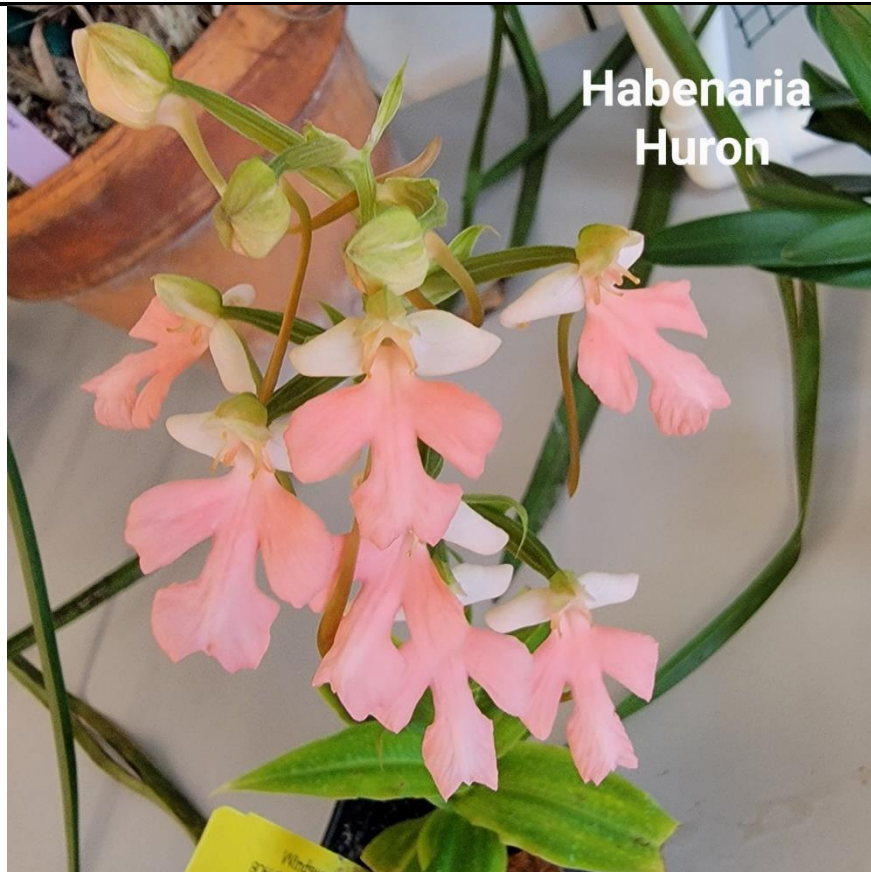
Give a presentation – 10 points
