Due to the short notice, we will not be putting up a display this year.

The first show of the year we will be participating in is the Ann Arbor Orchid Society Show and Sale, which is taking place November 18th and 19th with set up on the 17th. If you would like to volunteer to help set up or tear down, please let Alison know at your earliest convenience.

The schedule at the bottom of the newsletter will be updated with dates as soon as societies begin registering them with the American Orchid Society. Please look and plan to see where you can assist, particularly for the away shows. If we do not have enough volunteers for both set up and tear down, we will have to send our regrets to the hosting society. It is a courtesy we attend and support their shows as they attend and support ours. Please keep this in mind.

Showing Plants

With the first show of the season rapidly approaching, the time to start checking your plants is now. Even if you have not been growing anything outside this season, orchid pests can still make their way into your collections.

Any plants you have that are in spike/sheath/bud and may make their way into a show display need to be checked over regularly and treated at the first sign of an issue. For those that do not use any sorts of pesticides, there are plenty of other organic options such as horticultural oils and isopropyl alcohol, depending on the type of insect you find. If you send an orchid to a show with any sort of pest, they will spread to other plants in the display. Please do not be that person and make sure you are only sending healthy, pest free plants to shows.



August Webinars:


August is summer break for AOS and there is not a schedule of webinars or events for this month. Instead, this makes a good time to go back through the archived webinars to catch up on any you might have missed.





