SEA TURTLE NESTING SEASON

The season runs from May 1 through October 31. All beach furniture and equipment must be removed from the beach each night. Between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. ET, homeowners should shield, lower, or redirect all point sources of light visible from the beach. Amber or red lights may be used otherwise. Lee County Code Enforcement will be monitoring for non-compliance and issuing citations as warranted.
