SEVERE WEATHER

The 2024 Atlantic Hurricane Season is underway until November 30, 2024. Visit our companion website www.scsfl.org for severe weather alerts and emergency preparedness information. On August 3-4, 2024, Tropical Storm Debby passed about 130 miles west of Captiva, delivering substantial rainfall and storm surge that resulted in localized flooding, power, and Internet outages.

BEACHES

Captiva beaches do not have lifeguards and swimming is at your own risk. There have been two swimming-related deaths so far this year — one located at Blind Pass and the other at Plantation Beach Club. Rip currents are strong, localized, and narrow currents of water that move directly away from the shore by cutting through the lines of breaking waves, like a river flowing out to sea, and are not uncommon in Captiva. Heed posted warning signs and be highly aware of rapidly changing wind and wave conditions. If you experience or witness an emergency event, call 911 immediately. Do not depend upon Resort security to assist or relay information to an official first responder.
